Adjectives That Start with YA, YE (9 Words)

yankee	Used by southerners for an inhabitant of a northern state in the united states (especially a union soldier) <i>This direction was continued in the 1976 release clang of the yankee reaper.</i>
yearlong	Lasting through a year <i>Ruhle died in houston, texas after a yearlong battle with multiple myeloma.</i>
yearly	Occurring or payable every year <i>Anyone know the stand of the ohio yearly meeting</i>
yeatsian	In the manner of william butler yeats
yelled	In a vehement outcry <i>The troops yelled for his appearance.</i>
yellow	Easily frightened <i>Magenta is the complement of green, and yellow the complement of blue.</i>
yellowed	Changed to a yellowish color by age <i>The parchment is coarse and yellowed by age.</i>
yellowish	Changed to a yellowish color by age <i>Magenta is the opposite of green, and yellow the opposite of blue.</i>
yemeni	Of or relating to or characteristic of yemen or its inhabitants <i>Reported to be in yemeni custody.</i>

Adjectives That Start with YI, YO (7 Words)

yielding	Inclined to yield to argument or influence or control <i>He demands that wotan fill the crack by yielding the ring.</i>
yogistic	Of or relating to yoga
yon	Distant but within sight (`yon' is dialectal) <i>Yon oasis is actually a virtual image.</i>

- yonder** Distant but within sight (‘yon’ is dialectal) *At the bottom of yonder cliff would please you better,*
- young** Being in its early stage *From a young age, o’reilly was a tall and gangly player.*
- younger** Not tried or tested by experience *At a young age, harold was found to exhibit the power to transmute into energy.*
- youngish** Harvested at an early stage of development; before complete maturity *He moved to the united states at a young age and was naturalized in 1880.*

Adjectives That Start with YU (5 Words)

- yucky** Highly offensive; arousing aversion or disgust *As for the vaporings, yes it does sound kinda yucky.*
- yugoslav** Of or relating to or characteristic of the former country of yugoslavia or its people or languages *See yugoslav dinar for an example.*
- yugoslavian** Of or relating to or characteristic of the former country of yugoslavia or its people or languages *The camouflage was not yugoslavian at all.*
- yuman** Of or relating to the language or culture of the yuma people *It is part of the yuman language family.*
- yummy** Extremely pleasing to the sense of taste *Kept forgetting to thank you for the yummy icecream.*
