<b>qatari</b>	Of or concerning qatar or its inhabitants <i>They were the first qatari team to do so.</i>
<b>quack</b>	Medically unqualified <i>If it swishes like a duck, quack quack.</i>
<b>quadrangular</b>	Of or relating to or shaped like a quadrangle <i>The seal is quadrangular in cross section.</i>
<b>quadrasonic</b>	Of or relating to quadraphony <i>The last release in the quadrasonic 8 track format was in 1978.</i>
<b>quadrasonic</b>	Of or relating to quadraphony
<b>quadrate</b>	Having four sides and four angles <i>I am not surprised that the laptop is quadrate.</i>
<b>quadratic</b>	Of or relating to or resembling a square <i>Rational quadratic covariance function.</i>
<b>quadrilateral</b>	Having four sides <i>The indian section is part of the ambitious golden quadrilateral project.</i>
<b>quadrillionth</b>	The ordinal number of one quadrillion in counting order <i>I believe they just computed a few digits around the quadrillionth one.</i>
<b>quadripartite</b>	Involving four parties <i>Quadripartite plaster rib vaulting.</i>
<b>quadrasonic</b>	Of or relating to quadraphony
<b>quadrasonic</b>	Of or relating to quadraphony
<b>quadruped</b>	Having four feet <i>At least one of them appears to a winged quadruped.</i>
<b>quadrupedal</b>	Having four feet <i>Quadrupedal movement for exercise.</i>
<b>quadruple</b>	Having four units or components <i>Why not disclose the quadruple, triple lives of certain politicians</i>

<b>quadruplex</b>	Having four units or components <i>Contrast with quadruplex recording.</i>
<b>quadruplicate</b>	Having four units or components
<b>quaggy</b>	Soft and watery
<b>quaint</b>	Attractively old-fashioned (but not necessarily authentic) <i>This quaint small town is home of the kerrobert tigers.</i>
<b>qualified</b>	Limited or restricted; not absolute <i>I have included reference to disavowal of papen and qualified.</i>
<b>qualitative</b>	Relating to or involving comparisons based on qualities <i>It is one of the tools of qualitative research.</i>
<b>quality</b>	Of high social status <i>Please examine the quality of the site.</i>
<b>quantal</b>	Of or relating to a quantum or capable of existing in only one of two states <i>Non quantal and quantal release of acetylcholine at the neuromuscular junction.</i>
<b>quantifiable</b>	Capable of being quantified <i>The difference is quantifiable i think.</i>
<b>quantitative</b>	Having a metric system based on relative duration of syllables <i>Contemporary behavioural quantitative genetics.</i>
<b>quantized</b>	Of or relating to a quantum or capable of existing in only one of two states <i>The predictive residual signal is quantized and encoded.</i>
<b>quarrelsome</b>	Given to quarreling <i>It doesn't look good for anyone to be quarrelsome.</i>
<b>quartan</b>	Occurring every fourth day (especially the fever and weakness of malaria) <i>He had long been suffering from a quartan ague, as well as gout and the stone.</i>
<b>quarterly</b>	Of or relating to or consisting of a quarter <i>Gastronomica is a quarterly journal that covers gastronomy and the food world.</i>
<b>quasi</b>	Having some resemblance <i>Boykin set for quasi former team.</i>
<b>quaternary</b>	Consisting of or especially arranged in sets of four <i>The quaternary sediments are of marine and fluvial alluvium of recent age.</i>
<b>quaternate</b>	Consisting of or especially arranged in sets of four
<b>queasy</b>	Causing or able to cause nausea <i>Divya is still queasy about the engagement.</i>
<b>quebecois</b>	Of or relating to quebec (especially to the french speaking inhabitants or their culture) <i>Quebecois is not considered a slur.</i>
<b>quechuan</b>	Of or relating to the quechua or their language <i>The people are predominantly indigenous citizens of quechuan descent.</i>
<b>queenlike</b>	Having the rank of or resembling or befitting a queen

<b>queenly</b>	Having the rank of or resembling or befitting a queen <i>Opis also acquired queenly status and was reputed to be an eminent goddess.</i>
<b>queer</b>	Beyond or deviating from the usual or expected <i>I candidly confess a queer, queer race, of novel fashion.</i>
<b>quenchless</b>	Impossible to quench
<b>querulous</b>	Habitually complaining <i>I don't agree that the lead is querulous.</i>
<b>questionable</b>	Subject to question <i>The help of pollinator is questionable.</i>
<b>questioning</b>	Showing curiosity <i>I'm questioning the basis of the article.</i>
<b>quick</b>	Hurried and brief <i>In the interstices, quick sand was poured.</i>
<b>quick-sighted</b>	Keenly perceptive or alert- leonard bacon <i>She was temperamental and quick to fight.</i>
<b>quick-witted</b>	Mentally nimble and resourceful <i>He is quick witted about the idea of the mischief.</i>
<b>quicker</b>	Apprehending and responding with speed and sensitivity <i>She was temperamental and quick to fight.</i>
<b>quickest</b>	Accomplished rapidly and without delay <i>I appreciate the quick turnaround.</i>
<b>quicksset</b>	Grown from cuttings planted directly in the ground <i>In contrast, a quickset user would say phase line green while drawing a line.</i>
<b>quicksilver</b>	Liable to sudden unpredictable change <i>The weather is quicksilver, changing from sunny to cloudy.</i>
<b>quiescent</b>	Marked by a state of tranquil repose <i>My mind became quiescent.</i>
<b>quiet</b>	Not showy or obtrusive <i>He is quiet, pensive and very observant.</i>
<b>quieter</b>	Free from disturbance by heavy waves. <i>At college, he was quiet and unassuming.</i>
<b>quietest</b>	Free from disturbance by heavy waves. <i>People thought that he is reserved and quiet.</i>
<b>quilted</b>	Made of layers of fabric held together by patterned stitching. <i>It is vertically quilted, with wool stuffing and a silk satin lining.</i>
<b>quincentenary</b>	Of or relating to the 500th anniversary. <i>Celebrations for the quincentenary of his death are arranged for 2009.</i>
<b>quincentennial</b>	Of or relating to the 500th anniversary
<b>quinquefoliate</b>	Having five leaflets
<b>quintessential</b>	Representing the perfect example of a class or quality. <i>Apple is the quintessential fruit.</i>
<b>quintillionth</b>	The ordinal number of one quintillion in counting order

<b>quintuple</b>	Having five units or components. <i>It is believed to contain a quintuple bond.</i>
<b>quirky</b>	Informal terms; strikingly unconventional. <i>Gilda is a quirky, likable, gutsy and funny character.</i>
<b>quixotic</b>	Not sensible about practical matters; idealistic and unrealistic. <i>Heroes are defined as stouthearted and lion-hearted, quixotic and courtly, major league and mythical.</i>
<b>quizzical</b>	Playfully vexing (especially by ridicule). <i>It is the first known analysis of this quizzical achievement gap.</i>
<b>quondam</b>	Belonging to some prior time <i>Deep halls all represent the life of the quondam owner.</i>
<b>quotable</b>	Able or fit to be repeated or quoted <i>His sermons and quotable quotes are plentifully available in printed books.</i>
<b>quotidian</b>	Found in the ordinary course of events. <i>The quotes section is extremely quotidian.</i>
