## Adjectives That Start with JA (27 Words)

<b>jacksonian</b>	Of or pertaining to Andrew Jackson or his presidency or his concepts of popular democracy. <i>Now jacksonian populism can be 'heard' as well as read.</i>
<b>jacobeau</b>	Of or relating to James I or his reign or times. <i>There is no jacobeau drama of any sort.</i>
<b>Jacobinic</b>	Of or relating to the Jacobins of the French revolution
<b>Jacobinical</b>	Of or relating to the Jacobins of the French revolution
<b>jade</b>	Of something having the color of jade; especially varying from bluish-green to yellowish-green. Jade is also the state gemstone of the state of Wyoming.
<b>jaded</b>	Dulled by surfeit. <i>Hatred of the government gave way to a jaded contempt.</i>
<b>jadish</b>	Of something having the color of jade; especially varying from bluish green to yellowish-green. There is a commercial nephrite jade mine near Cowell.
<b>jagged</b>	Having an irregularly notched or toothed margin as though gnawed. <i>The appearance is extremely jagged.</i>
<b>jaggy</b>	Having an irregularly notched or toothed margin as though gnawed. <i>A taxicab space line.. at an infinitesimal level it'd still be jaggy.</i>
<b>Jain</b>	Relating to or characteristic of Jainism. <i>The jinas or Tirthankaras occupy the most exalted position in Jain pantheon.</i>

<b>Jainist</b>	Relating to or characteristic of Jainism. The shvetambaras are the other main Jainist sect.
<b>jam-packed</b>	Filled to capacity. <i>Thimbleberry and chokecherry jam is a treat.</i>
<b>Jamaican</b>	Of or relating to Jamaica (the island or the country) or to its inhabitants. <i>One Panamanian and one Jamaican.</i>
<b>jamesian</b>	Of or relating to or characteristic of William James or his philosophy or his teachings. <i>The trope of the ghost has been deemed Jamesian.</i>
<b>jammed</b>	Filled to capacity. <i>When Coppola squeezed the trigger, the gun jammed.</i>
<b>jangling</b>	Like the discordant ringing of nonmusical metallic objects striking together <i>It is a violent shade of red that is jangling my nerves.</i>
<b>jangly</b>	Like the discordant ringing of nonmusical metallic objects striking together <i>Agreed, this barely scratches the surface of jangly pop bands...</i>
<b>Janus-faced</b>	Having two faces—one looking to the future and one to the past <i>The pontificate faced extraordinary problems.</i>
<b>Japanese</b>	Of or relating to or characteristic of Japan or its people or their culture or language. <i>Japanese is the language of the school.</i>
<b>jarring</b>	Making or causing a harsh and irritating sound. <i>I personally consider the previous format extremely jarring to the eye.</i>
<b>jaundiced</b>	Showing or affected by prejudice or envy or distaste <i>Call me jaundiced, but I can't see what this adds to the article.</i>
<b>jaunty</b>	Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air— frances g. patton-h.m.reynolds <i>Is it ok to add a screenshot of the default desktop for jaunty now</i>
<b>javan</b>	Of or relating to or characteristic of Java or its inhabitants or its language <i>Javan leopards are listed as being critically endangered.</i>
<b>javanese</b>	Of or relating to or characteristic of Java or its inhabitants or its language <i>There are many non Javanese who speak Javanese.</i>
<b>jawed</b>	Of animals having jaws of a specified type <i>One term has a reasonable base in fact, the other is flap jawed speculation.</i>
<b>jawless</b>	Of animals having no jaw <i>List of prehistoric jawless fish.</i>
<b>jazzy</b>	Resembling jazz (especially in its rhythm) <i>The guitar also had a jazzy and jangly type tone.</i>

## Adjectives That Start with JE (18 Words)

<b>jealous</b>	Showing extreme cupidity; painfully desirous of another's advantages <i>Danny is jealous and throws marcos in the water with a life preserver.</i>
<b>jeffersonian</b>	Relating to or characteristic of thomas jefferson or his principles or theories <i>Americans live in a jeffersonian political system with a hamilton economy.</i>
<b>jejune</b>	Lacking in nutritive value <i>We simply don't need an exhaustive list of jejune parliamentary maneuvers.</i>
<b>jellied</b>	Congeaed into jelly; solidified by cooling <i>This is used as a thickening agent make jellied gasoline.</i>
<b>jellylike</b>	Thick like gelatin <i>The eggs of fish and amphibians are jellylike.</i>
<b>jerkwater</b>	Small and remote and insignificant <i>I don't think this explanation of jerkwater is correct.</i>
<b>jerky</b>	Lacking a steady rhythm <i>Cartman happily feeds some of the jerky to one of the calves.</i>
<b>jerry-built</b>	Of inferior workmanship and materials <i>Jerry preston was the prospective investor into the school.</i>
<b>jesting</b>	Characterized by jokes and good humor <i>Jesting aside, that is very interesting about size and speed.</i>
<b>jesuit</b>	Having qualities characteristic of jesuits or jesuitism <i>The library of the jesuit university.</i>
<b>jesuitic</b>	Having qualities characteristic of jesuits or jesuitism
<b>jesuitical</b>	Having qualities characteristic of jesuits or jesuitism <i>Now all this jesuitical argumentation is unnecessary.</i>
<b>jet</b>	Of the blackest black; similar to the color of jet or coal <i>He saw a jet in the sky and screamed.</i>
<b>jet-black</b>	Of the blackest black; similar to the color of jet or coal <i>Calamitous orders beautiful to strap jimmy and jet to a pendulum.</i>
<b>jetting</b>	Of the blackest black; similar to the color of jet or coal <i>He saw a jet in the sky and screamed.</i>
<b>jeweled</b>	Covered with beads or jewels or sequins <i>A jeweled watch should contain at least 7 jewels.</i>
<b>jewelled</b>	Covered with beads or jewels or sequins <i>Today most jewelled bearings are synthetic ruby or sapphire.</i>
<b>jewish</b>	Of or relating to jews or their culture or religion <i>Born by a jewish mother, arquette did not fully submerse himself in his jewish heritage until age 40.</i>

- jiggered** Surprised *Maxwell's equations is constantly being jiggered in dubious ways.*
- jihadi** Of or relating to a jihad *However, it has been labelled as a cover for a jihadi forum by sofir.*
- jilted** Rebuffed (by a lover) without warning *The jilted mistress of a nobleman.*
- jingly** Having a series of high-pitched ringing sounds like many small bells *He finds lady jingly sitting on a little heap of stones.*
- jinxed** Causing or accompanied by misfortune *I'm convinced some deity saw this and jinxed the weather.*
- jittering** Undergoing small rapid variations
- jittery** Characterized by jerky movements *He seems vulnerable and jittery at times.*

- jobless** Not having a job *An estimated 30 percent of the workforce was jobless.*
- jocose** Characterized by jokes and good humor *I don't want to hear his jocose voice.*
- jocular** Characterized by jokes and good humor *The article text was jocular, but true.*
- jocund** Full of or showing high-spirited merriment- wordsworth
- joint** Affecting or involving two or more *The arm was twisted from the elbow joint.*
- jointed** Having joints or jointed segments; *The links are jointed by a hinge.*
- jolly** Full of or showing high-spirited merriment- wordsworth *He is the boatswain of the 'jolly roger'.*
- jolty** Causing or characterized by jolts and irregular movements
- jordanian** Of or relating to or characteristic of jordan or its people *No emergency was felt on the jordanian border.*
- journalistic** Of or relating to or having the characteristics of journalism *It was not a journalistic statement.*
- jovial** Full of or showing high-spirited merriment- wordsworth *I was trying to be jovial for the holiday.*
- jovian** Of or pertaining to or characteristic of or resembling the planet jupiter *I'll look up the life of jovian.*
- jowly** Having sagging folds of flesh beneath the chin or lower jaw
- joyful** Full of high-spirited delight *It depicts the joyful emotions of the farmers.*

<b>joyless</b>	Not experiencing or inspiring joy <i>She owns a cafeteria and maintains an orderly, joyless existence.</i>
<b>joyous</b>	Full of or characterized by joy <i>People were joyous in celebration of the preserver.</i>

## Adjectives That Start with JU (31 Words)

<b>jubilant</b>	Full of high-spirited delight <i>Police said the two attacks deliberately targeted the jubilant supporters.</i>
<b>judaic</b>	Of or relating to or characteristic of the jews or their culture or religion <i>The work is representative of the judaic inspiration of the composer.</i>
<b>judaical</b>	Of or relating to or characteristic of the jews or their culture or religion
<b>judgmental</b>	Depending on judgment <i>It is otiose and subjectively judgmental.</i>
<b>judicable</b>	Capable of being judged or decided
<b>judicial</b>	Decreed by or proceeding from a court of justice <i>The highest court of judicial branch is the supreme council of the magistracy.</i>
<b>judicious</b>	Marked by the exercise of good judgment or common sense in practical matters <i>Clearly has the judicious and pensive disposition required of an admin.</i>
<b>jugular</b>	Relating to or located in the region of the neck or throat <i>The botched decapitation in 1945 missed his brain stem and jugular vein.</i>
<b>juiceless</b>	Lacking juice
<b>juicy</b>	Having strong sexual appeal <i>The only juicy bite of steak will be the first.</i>
<b>julian</b>	Of or relating to or characteristic of julius caesar <i>Julian brazier is a member of the cornerstone group of conservative mps.</i>
<b>jumbo</b>	Of great mass; huge and bulky <i>Improbably, the tying touchdown was caught by offensive tackle jumbo elliott.</i>
<b>jumentous</b>	Smelling strongly like a beast of burden
<b>jumpy</b>	Causing or characterized by jolts and irregular movements <i>Others are so jumpy, it's embarrassing.</i>
<b>jungian</b>	Of or relating to carl jung or his psychological theories <i>Active imagination is the central technique in jungian therapy.</i>
<b>jungly</b>	Overgrown with tropical vegetation
<b>junior</b>	Including or intended for youthful persons <i>He had the rank of the junior lieutenant.</i>
<b>junoesque</b>	Suggestive of a statue

<b>jural</b>	Of or relating to law or to legal rights and obligations <i>I think mr jural is not yet up to speed on what this project is all about.</i>
<b>jurassic</b>	Of or relating to or denoting the second period of the mesozoic era <i>It dates to the jurassic period.</i>
<b>juridic</b>	Relating to the administration of justice or the function of a judge <i>The reception of a person already baptized has the same juridic effect.</i>
<b>juridical</b>	Of or relating to the law or jurisprudence <i>Has he failed to distinguish between the juridical and the sacramental fields</i>
<b>jurisdictional</b>	Restricted to the geographic area under a particular jurisdiction <i>That is by no stretch a jurisdictional argument.</i>
<b>juristic</b>	Of or relating to law or to legal rights and obligations <i>But you can use for such juristic problems your mind.</i>
<b>jury-rigged</b>	Done or made using whatever is available <i>The jury brought in a verdict of acquittal.</i>
<b>just</b>	Free from favoritism or self-interest or bias or deception; conforming with established standards or rules <i>Is this just a view expressed by right wing jingoist pundits</i>
<b>justifiable</b>	Capable of being justified <i>I added the reasons why i believe the article is justifiable.</i>
<b>justificative</b>	Attempting to justify or defend in speech or writing
<b>justificatory</b>	Attempting to justify or defend in speech or writing <i>It is not impossible for an infinite justificatory series to exist.</i>
<b>justified</b>	Having words so spaced that lines have straight even margins <i>John justified his claim more clearly.</i>
<b>juvenile</b>	Displaying or suggesting a lack of maturity <i>Yet there is more juvenile delinquency and more alienation among the young.</i>

There are not so many adjectives that start with 'J'. That's because this letter didn't enter the English language until later in history. Yet, these adjectives, like all others, add colors and emotions to narration and we hope our list of J adjectives was helpful.
