## The Forms of Abide

Infinitive	<b>to abide</b>
Present Tense	<b>abide / abides</b>
Past Tense	<b>abode or abided</b>
Present Participle	<b>abiding</b>
Past Participle	<b>abode, abided, or (rare), abidden</b>

## Conjugate Abide

**Abide in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>abide</b>	We <b>abide</b>
You <b>abide</b>	You <b>abide</b>
He/She/It <b>abides</b>	They <b>abide</b>

### **Abide in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am abiding</b>	We <b>are abiding</b>
You <b>are abiding</b>	You <b>are abiding</b>
He/She/It <b>is abiding</b>	They <b>are abiding</b>

### **Abide in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have abode, abided, or (rare), abidden</b>	We <b>have abode, abided, or (rare), abidden</b>
You <b>have abode, abided, or (rare), abidden</b>	You <b>have abode, abided, or (rare), abidden</b>
He/She/It <b>has abode, abided, or (rare), abidden</b>	They <b>have abode, abided, or (rare), abidden</b>

### **Abide in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been abiding</b>	We <b>have been abiding</b>
You <b>have been abiding</b>	You <b>have been abiding</b>
He/She/It <b>has been abiding</b>	They <b>have been abiding</b>

I <b>abode or abided</b>	We <b>abode or abided</b>
You <b>abode or abided</b>	You <b>abode or abided</b>
He/She/It <b>abode or abided</b>	They <b>abode or abided</b>

**I was abiding**

**We were abiding**

**You were abiding**

**You were abiding**

**He/She/It was abiding**

**They were abiding**

## **Abide in Past Perfect Tense**

### **Singular**

### **Plural**

**I had abode, abided, or (rare), abidden**

**We had abode, abided, or (rare), abidden**

**You had abode, abided, or (rare), abidden**

**You had abode, abided, or (rare), abidden**

**He/She/It had abode, abided, or (rare), abidden**

**They had abode, abided, or (rare), abidden**

## **Abide in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

### **Plural**

**I had been abiding**

**We had been abiding**

**You had been abiding**

**You had been abiding**

**He/She/It had been abiding**

**They had been abiding**

## **Abide in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

### **Singular**

### **Plural**

**I will abide**

**We will abide**

**You will abide**

**You will abide**

**He/She/It will abide**

**They will abide**

## **Abide in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

### **Singular**

### **Plural**

**I will be abiding**

**We will be abiding**

**You will be abiding**

**You will be abiding**

**Singular**

**Plural**

He/She/It **will be abiding** They **will be abiding**

**Abide in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

I **will have abode, abided, or (rare),  
abidden**

We **will have abode, abided, or (rare),  
abidden**

You **will have abode, abided, or (rare),  
abidden**

You **will have abode, abided, or (rare),  
abidden**

He/She/It **will have abode, abided, or  
(rare), abidden**

They **will have abode, abided, or (rare),  
abidden**
