Abjudge in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I was abjudging We were abjudging
You were abjudging You were abjudging
He/She/It was abjudging They were abjudging

Abjudge in Past Perfect Tense

I had abjudged We had abjudged
You had abjudged You had abjudged
He/She/It had abjudged They had abjudged

Abjudge in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been abjudging We had been abjudging
You had been abjudging You had been abjudging
He/She/It had been abjudging They had been abjudging

Abjudge in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will abjudge We will abjudge
You will abjudge You will abjudge
He/She/It will abjudge They will abjudge

Abjudge in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be abjudging We will be abjudging
You will be abjudging You will be abjudging
He/She/It will be abjudging They will be abjudging

Abjudge in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have adjudged

We will have adjudged

You will have adjudged

You will have adjudged

He/She/It will have adjudged **They will have adjudged**

Abjudge in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been adjudging

We will have been adjudging

You will have been adjudging

You will have been adjudging

He/She/It will have been adjudging **They will have been adjudging**
