## **Conjugate Abrupt**

#### **Abrupt in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>abrupt</b>	We <b>abrupt</b>
You <b>abrupt</b>	You <b>abrupt</b>
He/She/It abrupts	They <b>abrupt</b>

## **Abrupt in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am abrupting	We <b>are abrupting</b>
You <b>are abrupting</b>	You <b>are abrupting</b>
He/She/It is abrupting	They are abrupting

## **Abrupt in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have abrupted	We have abrupted
You have abrupted	You have abrupted
He/She/It has abrupted	They have abrupted

## **Abrupt in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been abrupting	We have been abrupting
You have been abrupting	You <b>have been abrupting</b>
He/She/It has been abrupting	They have been abrupting

## Abrupt in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I abrupted	We <b>abrupted</b>
You <b>abrupted</b>	You <b>abrupted</b>
He/She/It abrupted	They <b>abrupted</b>

#### **Abrupt in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was abrupting	We were abrupting
You were abrupting	You were abrupting
He/She/It was abrupting	They were abrupting

## **Abrupt in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had abrupted	We had abrupted
You had abrupted	You had abrupted
He/She/It had abrupted	They had abrupted

## **Abrupt in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been abrupting	We had been abrupting
You <b>had been abrupting</b>	You had been abrupting
He/She/It had been abrupting	They had been abrupting

## Abrupt in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will abrupt	We <b>will abrupt</b>
You <b>will abrupt</b>	You <b>will abrupt</b>
He/She/It will abrupt	They will abrupt

## Abrupt in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be abrupting	We will be abrupting
You <b>will be abrupting</b>	You will be abrupting
He/She/It will be abrupting	They will be abrupting

## **Abrupt in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been abrupting	We <b>will have been abrupting</b>
You <b>will have been abrupting</b>	You <b>will have been abrupting</b>
He/She/It will have been abrupting	They will have been abrupting
