Present Tense	<b>accentuate / accentuates</b>
Past Tense	<b>accentuated</b>
Present Participle	<b>accentuating</b>
Past Participle	<b>accentuated</b>

## Conjugate Accentuate

### Accentuate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>accentuate</b>	We <b>accentuate</b>
You <b>accentuate</b>	You <b>accentuate</b>
He/She/It <b>accentuates</b>	They <b>accentuate</b>

**Accentuate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am accentuating</b>	We <b>are accentuating</b>
You <b>are accentuating</b>	You <b>are accentuating</b>
He/She/It <b>is accentuating</b>	They <b>are accentuating</b>

**Accentuate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have accentuated</b>	We <b>have accentuated</b>
You <b>have accentuated</b>	You <b>have accentuated</b>
He/She/It <b>has accentuated</b>	They <b>have accentuated</b>

**Accentuate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been accentuating</b>	We <b>have been accentuating</b>
You <b>have been accentuating</b>	You <b>have been accentuating</b>
He/She/It <b>has been accentuating</b>	They <b>have been accentuating</b>

**Plural**

I <b>accentuated</b>	We <b>accentuated</b>
You <b>accentuated</b>	You <b>accentuated</b>
He/She/It <b>accentuated</b>	They <b>accentuated</b>

**Accentuate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was accentuating**      We **were accentuating**  
You **were accentuating**      You **were accentuating**  
He/She/It **was accentuating**      They **were accentuating**

**Accentuate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had accentuated**      We **had accentuated**  
You **had accentuated**      You **had accentuated**  
He/She/It **had accentuated**      They **had accentuated**

**Accentuate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been accentuating**      We **had been accentuating**  
You **had been accentuating**      You **had been accentuating**  
He/She/It **had been accentuating**      They **had been accentuating**

**Accentuate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will accentuate**      We **will accentuate**  
You **will accentuate**      You **will accentuate**  
He/She/It **will accentuate**      They **will accentuate**

**Accentuate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be accentuating**      We **will be accentuating**  
You **will be accentuating**      You **will be accentuating**  
He/She/It **will be accentuating**      They **will be accentuating**

**Accentuate in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have accentuated**

**We will have accentuated**

**You will have accentuated**

**You will have accentuated**

**He/She/It will have accentuated**

**They will have accentuated**

**Accentuate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**I will have been accentuating**

**We will have been accentuating**

**You will have been accentuating**

**You will have been accentuating**

**He/She/It will have been accentuating**

**They will have been accentuating**
