Access in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I access
You access
You access

He/She/It accesses They access

Access in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am accessing We are accessing
You are accessing You are accessing
He/She/It is accessing They are accessing

Access in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have accessed We have accessed You have accessed He/She/It has accessed They have accessed

Access in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been accessing
You have been accessing
You have been accessing
He/She/It has been accessing
They have been accessing

Access in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I accessed We accessed
You accessed You accessed
He/She/It accessed They accessed

Access in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was accessing We were accessing
You were accessing You were accessing
He/She/It was accessing They were accessing

Access in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had accessed
You had accessed
He/She/It had accessed
They had accessed

Access in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been accessing
You had been accessing
He/She/It had been accessing
They had been accessing

Access in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will access
You will access
You will access

He/She/It will access They will access

Access in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be accessing
You will be accessing
He/She/It will be accessing
They will be accessing

Access in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have accessed
You will have accessed
He/She/It will have accessed
They will have accessed

Access in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been accessing
You will have been accessing
He/She/It will have been accessing
They will have been accessing
