Past Tense	<b>accessioned</b>
Present Participle	<b>accessioning</b>
Past Participle	<b>accessioned</b>

## Conjugate Accession

**Accession in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>accession</b>	We <b>accession</b>
You <b>accession</b>	You <b>accession</b>
He/She/It <b>accessions</b>	They <b>accession</b>

**Accession in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am accessioning</b>	We <b>are accessioning</b>
You <b>are accessioning</b>	You <b>are accessioning</b>
He/She/It <b>is accessioning</b>	They <b>are accessioning</b>

**Accession in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have accessioned</b>	We <b>have accessioned</b>
You <b>have accessioned</b>	You <b>have accessioned</b>
He/She/It <b>has accessioned</b>	They <b>have accessioned</b>

**Accession in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been accessioning</b>	We <b>have been accessioning</b>
You <b>have been accessioning</b>	You <b>have been accessioning</b>
He/She/It <b>has been accessioning</b>	They <b>have been accessioning</b>

**Accession in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>accessioned</b>	We <b>accessioned</b>
You <b>accessioned</b>	You <b>accessioned</b>
He/She/It <b>accessioned</b>	They <b>accessioned</b>

**Accession in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

I <b>was accessioning</b>	We <b>were accessioning</b>
You <b>were accessioning</b>	You <b>were accessioning</b>
He/She/It <b>was accessioning</b>	They <b>were accessioning</b>

**Accession in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>had accessioned</b>	We <b>had accessioned</b>
You <b>had accessioned</b>	You <b>had accessioned</b>
He/She/It <b>had accessioned</b>	They <b>had accessioned</b>

**Accession in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>had been accessioning</b>	We <b>had been accessioning</b>
You <b>had been accessioning</b>	You <b>had been accessioning</b>
He/She/It <b>had been accessioning</b>	They <b>had been accessioning</b>

**Accession in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>will accession</b>	We <b>will accession</b>
You <b>will accession</b>	You <b>will accession</b>
He/She/It <b>will accession</b>	They <b>will accession</b>

**Accession in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>will be accessioning</b>	We <b>will be accessioning</b>
You <b>will be accessioning</b>	You <b>will be accessioning</b>
He/She/It <b>will be accessioning</b>	They <b>will be accessioning</b>

**I will have accessioned**

**We will have accessioned**

**You will have accessioned**

**You will have accessioned**

**He/She/It will have accessioned**

**They will have accessioned**

**I will have been accessioning**

**We will have been accessioning**

**You will have been accessioning**

**You will have been accessioning**

**He/She/It will have been accessioning**

**They will have been accessioning**
