Accordion in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **accordion** We **accordion**
You **accordion** You **accordion**
He/She/It **accordions** They **accordion**

Accordion in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am accordioneing** We **are accordioneing**
You **are accordioneing** You **are accordioneing**
He/She/It **is accordioneing** They **are accordioneing**

Accordion in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have accordioned** We **have accordioned**
You **have accordioned** You **have accordioned**
He/She/It **has accordioned** They **have accordioned**

Accordion in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been accordioneing** We **have been accordioneing**
You **have been accordioneing** You **have been accordioneing**
He/She/It **has been accordioneing** They **have been accordioneing**

Accordion in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **accordioned** We **accordioned**
You **accordioned** You **accordioned**
He/She/It **accordioned** They **accordioned**

Accordion in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was accordioneing	We were accordioneing
You were accordioneing	You were accordioneing
He/She/It was accordioneing	They were accordioneing

Accordion in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had accordioned	We had accordioned
You had accordioned	You had accordioned
He/She/It had accordioned	They had accordioned

Accordion in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been accordioneing	We had been accordioneing
You had been accordioneing	You had been accordioneing
He/She/It had been accordioneing	They had been accordioneing

Accordion in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will accordion	We will accordion
You will accordion	You will accordion
He/She/It will accordion	They will accordion

Accordion in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be accordioneing	We will be accordioneing
You will be accordioneing	You will be accordioneing
He/She/It will be accordioneing	They will be accordioneing

Accordion in Future Perfect Tense

I will have accordioned

We will have accordioned

You will have accordioned

You will have accordioned

He/She/It will have accordioned

They will have accordioned

I will have been accordioning

We will have been accordioning

You will have been accordioning

You will have been accordioning

He/She/It will have been accordioning

They will have been accordioning
