I **account**                      We **account**  
You **account**                  You **account**  
He/She/It **accounts**      They **account**

**Account in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am accounting**              We **are accounting**  
You **are accounting**          You **are accounting**  
He/She/It **is accounting**      They **are accounting**

**Account in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have accounted**              We **have accounted**  
You **have accounted**          You **have accounted**  
He/She/It **has accounted**      They **have accounted**

**Account in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

I **have been accounting**          We **have been accounting**  
You **have been accounting**      You **have been accounting**  
He/She/It **has been accounting**      They **have been accounting**

**Account in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I **accounted**                      We **accounted**  
You **accounted**                  You **accounted**  
He/She/It **accounted**          They **accounted**

**Account in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I **was** **accourting**      We **were** **accourting**  
You **were** **accourting**      You **were** **accourting**  
He/She/It **was** **accourting**      They **were** **accourting**

**Accourt in Past Perfect Tense**

I **had** **accourted**      We **had** **accourted**  
You **had** **accourted**      You **had** **accourted**  
He/She/It **had** **accourted**      They **had** **accourted**

I **had been** **accourting**      We **had been** **accourting**  
You **had been** **accourting**      You **had been** **accourting**

**Accourt in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I **will** **accourt**      We **will** **accourt**  
You **will** **accourt**      You **will** **accourt**  
He/She/It **will** **accourt**      They **will** **accourt**

**Accourt in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I **will be** **accourting**      We **will be** **accourting**  
You **will be** **accourting**      You **will be** **accourting**  
He/She/It **will be** **accourting**      They **will be** **accourting**

**Accourt in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**I will have accourted**

**We will have accourted**

**You will have accourted**

**You will have accourted**

**He/She/It will have accourted**

**They will have accourted**

**I will have been accourting**

**We will have been accourting**

**You will have been accourting**

**You will have been accourting**

**He/She/It will have been accourting**

**They will have been accourting**
