adjust

His eyes had adjusted to semi darkness.

assimilate Become similar in sound.

This country **assimilate**s immigrants very quickly.



attune Accustom or acclimatize.

A society more **attune**d to consumerism than ideology.

become resigned Undergo a change or development.

Of a beer become conditioned.

condition O Brien **condition**ed winners of 13 European Derbies during his

career.

habituate Make or become accustomed or used to something.

She became **habituate**d to the background music.

harden Cause to accept or become hardened to habituate.

As oil prices **harden**ed from their recent lows the US dollar fell.

inure Cause to accept or become hardened to; habituate.

He was **inure**d to the cold.

reconcile

Make someone accept (a disagreeable or unwelcome thing.

The king and the archbishop were publicly **reconcile**d.

Voluntarily leave a job or office.

resign

He vows to resign himself to her direction.
