Definitions of "Acculturate" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “acculturate” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Assimilate to a different culture, typically the dominant one.*
- *Assimilate culturally.*

Synonyms of "Acculturate" as a verb (13 Words)

acclimatize	Become accustomed to a new climate or new conditions; adjust. <i>It s unknown whether people will acclimatize to increasingly warm weather.</i>
accommodate	(of a building or other area) provide lodging or sufficient space for. <i>Can you accommodate me with a rental car.</i>
adapt	Adapt or conform oneself to new or different conditions. <i>A large organization can be slow to adapt to change.</i>
adjust	Decide how much is to be paid on an insurance claim. <i>His eyes had adjusted to semi darkness.</i>
assimilate	Become similar in sound. <i>This country assimilates immigrants very quickly.</i>

attune	Accustom or acclimatize. <i>A society more attuned to consumerism than ideology.</i>
become resigned	Undergo a change or development.
condition	Of a beer become conditioned. <i>O'Brien conditioned winners of 13 European Derbies during his career.</i>
habituate	Make or become accustomed or used to something. <i>She became habituated to the background music.</i>
<u>harden</u>	Cause to accept or become hardened to habituate. <i>As oil prices hardened from their recent lows the US dollar fell.</i>
inure	Cause to accept or become hardened to; habituate. <i>He was inured to the cold.</i>
<u>reconcile</u>	Make someone accept (a disagreeable or unwelcome thing). <i>The king and the archbishop were publicly reconciled.</i>
resign	Voluntarily leave a job or office. <i>He vows to resign himself to her direction.</i>

Usage Examples of "Acculturate" as a verb

- *Those who have acculturated to the United States.*
- *The next weeks were spent acculturating the field staff.*
