Definitions of "Acculturation" as a noun

- *Assimilation to a different culture, typically the dominant one.*
- *All the knowledge and values shared by a society.*
- *The process of assimilating new ideas into an existing cognitive structure.*

Synonyms of "Acculturation" as a noun (5 Words)

<u>assimilation</u>	The fact of a sound being made more like another in the same or next word. <i>The assimilation of Italians into American society.</i>
culture	A preparation of cells obtained by culture. <i>The bacterium was isolated in two blood cultures.</i>
enculturation	The adoption of the behavior patterns of the surrounding culture.
socialisation	The action of establishing on a socialist basis.
<u>socialization</u>	The action of establishing on a socialist basis. <i>There was too much socialization with the enlisted men.</i>
