Infinitive	to accurse
Present Tense	accurse / accurses
Past Tense	accursed
Present Participle	accursing
Past Participle	accursed or accurst

Conjugate Accurse

Accurse in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **accuse** We **accuse**
You **accuse** You **accuse**
He/She/It **accuses** They **accuse**

Accuse in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am accusing** We **are accusing**
You **are accusing** You **are accusing**
He/She/It **is accusing** They **are accusing**

Accuse in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have accused or accused** We **have accused or accused**
You **have accused or accused** You **have accused or accused**
He/She/It **has accused or accused** They **have accused or accused**

Accuse in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been accusing** We **have been accusing**
You **have been accusing** You **have been accusing**
He/She/It **has been accusing** They **have been accusing**

Accuse in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **accused** We **accused**
You **accused** You **accused**
He/She/It **accused** They **accused**

Accuse in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was accursing We were accursing
You were accursing You were accursing
He/She/It was accursing They were accursing

Accurse in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had accursed or accurst We had accursed or accurst
You had accursed or accurst You had accursed or accurst
He/She/It had accursed or accurst They had accursed or accurst

Accurse in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been accursing We had been accursing
You had been accursing You had been accursing
He/She/It had been accursing They had been accursing

Accurse in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will accurse We will accurse
You will accurse You will accurse
He/She/It will accurse They will accurse

Accurse in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be accursing We will be accursing
You will be accursing You will be accursing
He/She/It will be accursing They will be accursing

Accurse in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have accursed or accurst

We will have accursed or accurst

You will have accursed or accurst

You will have accursed or accurst

He/She/It will have accursed or accurst **They will have accursed or accurst**

Accurse in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been accursing

We will have been accursing

You will have been accursing

You will have been accursing

He/She/It will have been accursing **They will have been accursing**
