He/She/It has ached or (obsolete) aken

They have ached or (obsolete) aken

Ache in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been aching We have been aching

You have been aching They have been aching

I had been aching
You had been aching
He/She/It had been aching
They had been aching

Ache in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will ache We will ache
You will ache
He/She/It will ache They will ache

Ache in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be aching
You will be aching
He/She/It will be aching
They will be aching

You will have ached or (obsolete) aken
