Definitions of "Achy" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “achy” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Causing a dull and steady pain.*
- *Suffering from continuous dull pain.*

Synonyms of "Achy" as an adjective (8 Words)

aching	Causing a dull and steady pain. <i>I write this letter with tears in my eyes and an aching heart.</i>
hurt	Damaged inanimate objects or their value. <i>Dogs and cats with hurt paws.</i>
<u>painful</u>	Causing misery or pain or distress. <i>The painful process of growing up.</i>
sore	Roused to anger- Mark Twain. <i>She had a sore throat.</i>
<u>stiff</u>	Not moving or operating freely. <i>Stiff hair.</i>
<u>tender</u>	Young and immature. <i>Tender memories.</i>

troublesome Causing difficulty or annoyance.
A ***troublesome*** situation.

uncomfortable Causing or feeling unease or awkwardness.
He began to feel ***uncomfortable*** at the man's hard stare.

Usage Examples of "Achy" as an adjective

- *She felt tired and achy.*
- *Her old achy joints.*
