aching	Causing a dull and steady pain. I write this letter with tears in my eyes and an aching heart.
hurt	Damaged inanimate objects or their value. <i>Dogs and cats with hurt paws.</i>
<u>painful</u>	Causing misery or pain or distress. The painful process of growing up.
sore	Roused to anger- Mark Twain. She had a sore throat.
<u>stiff</u>	Not moving or operating freely. <i>Stiff</i> hair.
tender	Young and immature. Tender memories.



troublesomeCausing difficulty or annoyance.
A troublesome situation.uncomfortableCausing or feeling unease or awkwardness.
He began to feel uncomfortable at the man s hard stare.
