- *Suffering from continuous dull pain.*

### Synonyms of "Achy" as an adjective (8 Words)

<b>aching</b>	Causing a dull and steady pain. <i>I write this letter with tears in my eyes and an <b>aching</b> heart.</i>
<b>hurt</b>	Damaged inanimate objects or their value. <i>Dogs and cats with <b>hurt</b> paws.</i>
<b><u>painful</u></b>	Causing misery or pain or distress. <i>The <b>painful</b> process of growing up.</i>
<b>sore</b>	Roused to anger- Mark Twain. <i>She had a <b>sore</b> throat.</i>
<b><u>stiff</u></b>	Not moving or operating freely. <i><b>Stiff</b> hair.</i>
<b><u>tender</u></b>	Young and immature. <i><b>Tender</b> memories.</i>

**troublesome** Causing difficulty or annoyance.  
A ***troublesome*** situation.

**uncomfortable** Causing or feeling unease or awkwardness.  
He began to feel ***uncomfortable*** at the man's hard stare.

## Usage Examples of "Achy" as an adjective

- *She felt tired and achy.*
- *Her old achy joints.*
