Infinitive	to acknowledge
Present Tense	acknowledge / acknowledges
Past Tense	acknowledged
Present Participle	acknowledging
Past Participle	acknowledged

# **Conjugate Acknowledge**

#### Acknowledge in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I acknowledge	We <b>acknowledge</b>
You <b>acknowledge</b>	You <b>acknowledge</b>
He/She/It acknowledges	They acknowledge

#### Acknowledge in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am acknowledging	We are acknowledging
You <b>are acknowledging</b>	You <b>are acknowledging</b>
He/She/It is acknowledging	They are acknowledging

#### **Acknowledge in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have acknowledged	We have acknowledged
You <b>have acknowledged</b>	You have acknowledged
He/She/It has acknowledged	They have acknowledged

## Acknowledge in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been acknowledging	We have been acknowledging
You <b>have been acknowledging</b>	You have been acknowledging
He/She/It has been acknowledging	They have been acknowledging

### Acknowledge in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I acknowledged	We <b>acknowledged</b>
You <b>acknowledged</b>	You <b>acknowledged</b>
He/She/It acknowledged	They <b>acknowledged</b>

#### Acknowledge in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was acknowledging	We were acknowledging
You <b>were acknowledging</b>	You were acknowledging
He/She/It was acknowledging	They were acknowledging

#### **Acknowledge in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had acknowledged	We had acknowledged
You <b>had acknowledged</b>	You had acknowledged
He/She/It had acknowledged	They had acknowledged

#### Acknowledge in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been acknowledging	We had been acknowledging
You <b>had been acknowledging</b>	You <b>had been acknowledging</b>
He/She/It had been acknowledging	They had been acknowledging

## Acknowledge in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will acknowledge	We <b>will acknowledge</b>
You <b>will acknowledge</b>	You <b>will acknowledge</b>
He/She/It will acknowledge	They will acknowledge

## Acknowledge in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be acknowledging	We <b>will be acknowledging</b>
You <b>will be acknowledging</b>	You <b>will be acknowledging</b>
He/She/It will be acknowledging	They will be acknowledging

#### Acknowledge in Future Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been acknowledging	We will have been acknowledging
You <b>will have been acknowledging</b>	You <b>will have been acknowledging</b>
He/She/It will have been acknowledging	They will have been acknowledging
