Associations of "Acquainted" (30 Words)

acquaintance	Acquaintances considered collectively. <i>The pupils had little acquaintance with the language.</i>
affiliated	Being joined in close association. <i>Affiliated union members.</i>
ambient	Relating to ambient music. <i>The ambient air.</i>
around	All around or on all sides. <i>Traveled around in Asia.</i>
close	Narrowly enclosed. <i>Close a wound.</i>
closely	In a way that involves a strong resemblance or connection. <i>Both children are clearly very closely attached to their parents.</i>
closeness	The quality of being done in an attentive and thorough way. <i>Their closeness grew as the night wore on.</i>
confidant	A person with whom one shares a secret or private matter, trusting them not to repeat it to others. <i>A close confidante of the princess.</i>
connected	Plugged in. <i>First check to see whether the appliance is connected.</i>
conversant	Familiar with or knowledgeable about something. <i>You need someone who is conversant with the new technology.</i>
directly	In a little while; soon. <i>The ceiling directly above the door.</i>
familiar	A spirit (usually in animal form) that acts as an assistant to a witch or wizard. <i>Familiar with the complex machinery.</i>

<u>familiarity</u>	A casual manner. <i>The unnecessary familiarity made me dislike him at once.</i>
familiarly	In an intimately familiar manner.
<u>friendship</u>	The emotions or conduct of friends; the state of being friends. <i>The foreign ministers extended to eastern Europe the hand of friendship.</i>
inextricable	Impossible to disentangle or separate. <i>An inextricable knot.</i>
informed	(of a decision or judgement) based on an understanding of the facts of the situation. <i>She lacks the ability to make an informed decision.</i>
interconnect	Be interwoven or interconnected. <i>The way human activities interconnect with the environment.</i>
<u>interdependent</u>	(of two or more people or things) dependent on each other. <i>We in Europe are all increasingly interdependent.</i>
interlinear	(of a book) having the same text in different languages printed on alternate lines. <i>A Greek English interlinear New Testament.</i>
intimacy	Sexual intercourse. <i>The intimacy between a husband and wife.</i>
intimate	Thoroughly acquainted through study or experience. <i>Intimate details of his sexual encounters.</i>
intimately	In a private and personal way. <i>Themes of love and death were intimately connected.</i>
<u>involvement</u>	Emotional or personal association with someone. <i>There was additional involvement of the liver and spleen.</i>
know	Be cognizant or aware of a fact or a specific piece of information possess knowledge or information about. <i>Do you know the poem well enough to recite it.</i>
linked	Connected by a link, as railway cars or trailer trucks.
prevailing	Having most appeal or influence; prevalent. <i>Prevailing winds.</i>
skillful	Having or showing knowledge and skill and aptitude. <i>The effect was achieved by skillful retouching.</i>
snug	Place (something) safely or cosily. <i>A well shaped hood for a snug fit.</i>

The tendency to associate with others and to form social groups.
