Infinitive	to acquit
Present Tense	acquit / acquits
Past Tense	acquitted or acquitted
Present Participle	acquitting or acquiting
Past Participle	acquitted or acquitted

Conjugate Acquit

Acquit in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **acquit** We **acquit**
You **acquit** You **acquit**
He/She/It **acquits** They **acquit**

Acquit in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am acquitting or acquiting** We **are acquitting or acquiting**
You **are acquitting or acquiting** You **are acquitting or acquiting**
He/She/It **is acquitting or acquiting** They **are acquitting or acquiting**

Acquit in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have acquitted or acquitted** We **have acquitted or acquitted**
You **have acquitted or acquitted** You **have acquitted or acquitted**
He/She/It **has acquitted or acquitted** They **have acquitted or acquitted**

Acquit in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been acquitting or acquiting** We **have been acquitting or acquiting**
You **have been acquitting or acquiting** You **have been acquitting or acquiting**
He/She/It **has been acquitting or acquiting** They **have been acquitting or acquiting**

I **acquitted or acquitted** We **acquitted or acquitted**
You **acquitted or acquitted** You **acquitted or acquitted**
He/She/It **acquitted or acquitted** They **acquitted or acquitted**

I was acquitting or acquiting

We were acquitting or acquiting

You were acquitting or acquiting

You were acquitting or acquiting

He/She/It was acquitting or acquiting

They were acquitting or acquiting

I had acquitted or acquitted

We had acquitted or acquitted

You had acquitted or acquitted

He/She/It had acquitted or acquitted

They had acquitted or acquitted

I had been acquitting or acquiting

We had been acquitting or acquiting

Acquit in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will acquit

We will acquit

You will acquit

You will acquit

He/She/It will acquit

They will acquit

Acquit in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be acquitting or acquiting

We will be acquitting or acquiting

You will be acquitting or acquiting

You will be acquitting or acquiting

He/She/It will be acquitting or acquiting

They will be acquitting or acquiting

Acquit in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

I will have acquitted or acquitted

You will have acquitted or acquitted

He/She/It will have acquitted or acquitted

Plural

We will have acquitted or acquitted

You will have acquitted or acquitted

They will have acquitted or acquitted

Acquit in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I will have been acquitting or acquitting

**You will have been acquitting or
acquitting**

**He/She/It will have been acquitting or
acquitting**

Plural

**We will have been acquitting or
acquitting**

**You will have been acquitting or
acquitting**

**They will have been acquitting or
acquitting**
