# **Conjugate Acquittance**

#### Acquittance in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I acquittance	We <b>acquittance</b>
You <b>acquittance</b>	You <b>acquittance</b>
He/She/It acquittances	They <b>acquittance</b>

### Acquittance in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am acquittancing	We are acquittancing
You <b>are acquittancing</b>	You are acquittancing
He/She/It is acquittancing	They are acquittancing

#### **Acquittance in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have acquittanced	We have acquittanced
You have acquittanced	You have acquittanced
He/She/It has acquittanced	They have acquittanced

### **Acquittance in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been acquittancing	We have been acquittancing
You <b>have been acquittancing</b>	You have been acquittancing
He/She/It has been acquittancing	They have been acquittancing

### Acquittance in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I acquittanced	We <b>acquittanced</b>
You <b>acquittanced</b>	You <b>acquittanced</b>
He/She/It acquittanced	They <b>acquittanced</b>

#### Acquittance in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was acquittancing	We were acquittancing
You <b>were acquittancing</b>	You were acquittancing
He/She/It was acquittancing	They were acquittancing

#### **Acquittance in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had acquittanced	We had acquittanced
You <b>had acquittanced</b>	You had acquittanced
He/She/It had acquittanced	They had acquittanced

#### **Acquittance in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been acquittancing	We had been acquittancing
You <b>had been acquittancing</b>	You <b>had been acquittancing</b>
He/She/It had been acquittancing	They had been acquittancing

### Acquittance in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will acquittance	We <b>will acquittance</b>
You <b>will acquittance</b>	You <b>will acquittance</b>
He/She/It will acquittance	They will acquittance

### Acquittance in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be acquittancing	We will be acquittancing
You <b>will be acquittancing</b>	You will be acquittancing
He/She/It will be acquittancing	They will be acquittancing
