Definitions of "Acronym" as a noun

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "acronym" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A word formed from the initial letters of the several words in the name.
- A word formed from the initial letters of the several words in the name and pronounced as one word.
- An abbreviation formed from the initial letters of other words and pronounced as a word (e.g. ASCII, NASA).

An abbreviation consisting of initial letters pronounced separately (e.g. BBC). initialism

NATO is an **initialism** for North Atlantic Treaty Organization.


short form The location on a baseball field where the shortstop is stationed.

A thing that represents or stands for something else, especially a material

object representing something abstract. **symbol**

The Star of David the Jewish symbol.






Usage Examples of "Acronym" as a noun

Associations of "Acronym" (30 Words)

alphabet A character set that includes letters and is used to write a language.

DNA s 4 letter **alphabet**.

alphabeticRelating to or expressed by a writing system that uses an alphabet.

An **alphabetic** arrangement.

A word that expresses a meaning opposed to the meaning of another word

in which case the two words are antonyms of each other.
