adaptable	Able to adjust to new conditions. <i>Rats are highly adaptable to change.</i>
adjustable	Capable of being changed so as to match or fit. <i>An adjustable spanner.</i>
agility	Ability to think and understand quickly. <i>Games teach hand eye coordination mental agility and alertness.</i>
answer	Give the correct answer or solution to. <i>The answer to poverty and unemployment is a properly funded range of services.</i>
celerity	A rate that is rapid.
ductile	Easily influenced. <i>Ductile copper.</i>
ductility	The malleability of something that can be drawn into threads or wires or hammered into thin sheets.
elasticity	The ability of an object or material to resume its normal shape after being stretched or compressed; stretchiness. <i>Aging can decrease the elasticity of your skin.</i>
flexibility	Willingness to change or compromise. <i>I enjoyed the flexibility of the schedule.</i>
flexible	Making or willing to make concessions. <i>Flexible schedules.</i>
impressionable	Easily impressed or influenced. <i>An impressionable age.</i>
labile	Readily undergoing change or breakdown. <i>A heat labile protein.</i>
limber	Attach the limber. <i>Limber a cannon.</i>

<u>malleable</u>	(of a metal or other material) able to be hammered or pressed into shape without breaking or cracking. <i>A malleable metal can be beaten into a sheet.</i>
plasticity	The quality of being easily shaped or moulded. <i>Fine clay at the right degree of plasticity is more useful.</i>
<u>pliable</u>	Able to adjust readily to different conditions. <i>They soaked the leather to made it pliable.</i>
pliant	Capable of being influenced or formed. <i>A pliant young tree.</i>
protean	Taking on different forms. <i>It is difficult to comprehend the whole of this protean subject.</i>
<u>quickness</u>	A rate that is rapid. <i>His quickness of mind gained him the respect of all parties.</i>
rapidity	The fact of happening at a great rate; swiftness. <i>Technology spreads with extraordinary rapidity.</i>
<u>reaction</u>	A person's ability to respond physically and mentally to external stimuli. <i>My immediate reaction was one of relief.</i>
reflex	In reflexology a response in a part of the body to stimulation of a corresponding point on the feet hands or head. <i>Sneezing is reflexive.</i>
resilience	The physical property of a material that can return to its original shape or position after deformation that does not exceed its elastic limit. <i>Nylon is excellent in wearability abrasion resistance and resilience.</i>
responsiveness	The quality of reacting quickly and positively. <i>The responsiveness of the vehicle.</i>
restore	Restore by replacing a part or putting together what is torn or broken. <i>The government restored confidence in the housing market.</i>
rounded	Having a spherical shape. <i>His large rounded stomach.</i>
<u>sensitive</u>	Being susceptible to the attitudes, feelings, or circumstances of others. <i>Spiders are sensitive to vibrations on their web.</i>
suppleness	The gracefulness of a person or animal that is flexible and supple. <i>He increased the leanness and suppleness of the organization.</i>
<u>susceptible</u>	(often followed by `of' or `to') yielding readily to or capable of. <i>Patients with liver disease may be susceptible to infection.</i>
versatility	Ability to adapt or be adapted to many different functions or activities. <i>The versatility of the modern computer as a study aid.</i>
