## Associations of "Addicting" (30 Words)

<b>addiction</b>	A formal award by a magistrate of a thing or person to another person (as the award of a debtor to his creditor); a surrender to a master. <i>Under Roman law <b>addiction</b> was the justification for slavery.</i>
<b>addictive</b>	Relating to or susceptible to being or becoming addicted to something. <i>A highly <b>addictive</b> drug.</i>
<b>adherent</b>	Someone who supports a particular party, person, or set of ideas. <i>Any <b>adherent</b> sand grains are easily removed.</i>
<b>alcohol</b>	Drink containing alcohol. <i>Polyvinyl <b>alcohol</b>.</i>
<b>alcoholic</b>	A person suffering from alcoholism. <i>His <b>alcoholic</b> daughter was the cause of his anxiety.</i>
<a href="#"><b>ash</b></a>	Strong elastic wood of any of various ash trees used for furniture and tool handles and sporting goods such as baseball bats. <i>I turned over the <b>ashes</b>.</i>
<b>binge</b>	A period of excessive indulgence in an activity, especially eating, drinking, or taking drugs. <i>Every so often he might <b>binge</b> a Netflix show.</i>
<b>cigarette</b>	An object similar to a cigarette containing a narcotic or herbal substance.
<a href="#"><b>compulsive</b></a>	A person with a compulsive disposition someone who feels compelled to do certain things. <i>A <b>compulsive</b> liar.</i>
<b>devotee</b>	A strong believer in a particular religion or god. <i><b>Devotees</b> of Krishna.</i>
<b>dope</b>	Carbonated drink flavored with extract from kola nuts dope is a southernism in the United States. <i>The resistors have been <b>doped</b>.</i>

<b>drinker</b>	A large brownish European moth, the caterpillar of which bears irritant hairs and is noted for drinking dew. <i>Coffee <b>drinkers</b>.</i>
<b>freak</b>	Behave or cause to behave in a wild and irrational way, typically because of the effects of extreme emotion or drugs. <i>He used to be called a <b>freak</b> at school and knows how much it hurts.</i>
<b>inebriate</b>	Drunk; intoxicated. <i>Those who feel inclined are free to <b>inebriate</b> themselves.</i>
<b>intoxicant</b>	A liquor or brew containing alcohol as the active agent. <i><b>Intoxicants</b> and drugs are used by some to escape physical or psychological pain.</i>
<b>intoxicate</b>	Poison (someone). <i>We don't allow people into sessions if they are <b>intoxicated</b> by alcohol or drugs.</i>
<b>nut</b>	Gather nuts. <i>A car <b>nut</b>.</i>
<b>overindulge</b>	Gratify the wishes of (someone) to an excessive extent. <i>His mother had <b>overindulged</b> him.</i>
<b>overuse</b>	Use (something) too much. <i>The word hero is <b>overused</b> these days.</i>
<b>peddler</b>	Someone who travels about selling his wares (as on the streets or at carnivals). <i><b>Peddlers</b> of dangerous Utopianism.</i>
<b>rehabilitate</b>	Return (something, especially a building or environmental feature) to its former condition. <i>The campaign aims to <b>rehabilitate</b> the river's flood plain.</i>
<a href="#"><u>revel</u></a>	Enjoy oneself in a lively and noisy way, especially with drinking and dancing. <i>Bill said he was secretly <b>revelling</b> in his new found fame.</i>
<b>smoker</b>	A person who smokes tobacco. <i>When the fish is ready put it in the warm <b>smoker</b>.</i>
<b>smoking</b>	The act of smoking tobacco or other substances. <i>The effect of <b>smoking</b> on health.</i>
<b>sobriety</b>	A manner that is serious and solemn. <i>She speaks with such <b>sobriety</b> it's clear she speaks the truth.</i>
<b>stimulant</b>	A substance that raises levels of physiological or nervous activity in the body. <i>A scalp <b>stimulant</b>.</i>
<b>tipple</b>	Drink moderately but regularly. <i>She drank several glasses of sherry her favourite <b>tipple</b>.</i>
