addiction	A formal award by a magistrate of a thing or person to another person (as the award of a debtor to his creditor); a surrender to a master. Under Roman law addiction was the justification for slavery.
addictive	Relating to or susceptible to being or becoming addicted to something. <i>A highly addictive drug.</i>
adherent	Someone who supports a particular party, person, or set of ideas. Any adherent sand grains are easily removed.
alcohol	Drink containing alcohol. Polyvinyl alcohol .
alcoholic	A person suffering from alcoholism. His alcoholic daughter was the cause of his anxiety.
<u>ash</u>	Strong elastic wood of any of various ash trees used for furniture and tool handles and sporting goods such as baseball bats. <i>I turned over the ashes.</i>
binge	A period of excessive indulgence in an activity, especially eating, drinking, or taking drugs. Every so often he might binge a Netflix show.
cigarette	An object similar to a cigarette containing a narcotic or herbal substance.
<u>compulsive</u>	A person with a compulsive disposition someone who feels compelled to do certain things. A compulsive liar.
devotee	A strong believer in a particular religion or god. Devotee s of Krishna.
dope	Carbonated drink flavored with extract from kola nuts dope is a southernism in the United States. <i>The resistors have been</i> dope <i>d</i> .



drinker	A large brownish European moth, the caterpillar of which bears irritant hairs and is noted for drinking dew. <i>Coffee drinkers</i> .
freak	Behave or cause to behave in a wild and irrational way, typically because of the effects of extreme emotion or drugs. He used to be called a freak at school and knows how much it hurts.
inebriate	Drunk; intoxicated. Those who feel inclined are free to inebriate themselves.
intoxicant	A liquor or brew containing alcohol as the active agent. Intoxicants and drugs are used by some to escape physical or psychological pain.
intoxicate	Poison (someone). We don t allow people into sessions if they are intoxicate d by alcohol or drugs.
nut	Gather nuts. <i>A car nut</i> .
overindulge	Gratify the wishes of (someone) to an excessive extent. <i>His mother had overindulged him.</i>
overuse	Use (something) too much. The word hero is overuse d these days.
peddler	Someone who travels about selling his wares (as on the streets or at carnivals. Peddler s of dangerous Utopianism.
rehabilitate	Return (something, especially a building or environmental feature) to its former condition. The campaign aims to rehabilitate the river s flood plain.
<u>revel</u>	Enjoy oneself in a lively and noisy way, especially with drinking and dancing. Bill said he was secretly revel ling in his new found fame.
smoker	A person who smokes tobacco. When the fish is ready put it in the warm smoker .
smoking	The act of smoking tobacco or other substances. The effect of smoking on health.
sobriety	A manner that is serious and solemn. She speaks with such sobriety it s clear she speaks the truth.
stimulant	A substance that raises levels of physiological or nervous activity in the body. <i>A scalp stimulant</i> .
tipple	Drink moderately but regularly. She drank several glasses of sherry her favourite tipple .
