# The Forms of Address

Infinitive to address

Present Tense address / addresses

Past Tense addressed or (obsolete) addrest

Present Participle addressing

# Address in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I address We address

You **address**He/She/It **addresses** They **address** 

### Address in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am addressing We are addressing
You are addressing You are addressing
He/She/It is addressing They are addressing

### **Address in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular Plural

I have addressed or (obsolete) addrest
You have addressed or (obsolete) addrest
You have addressed or (obsolete) addrest

He/She/It has addressed or (obsolete) They have addressed or (obsolete)

addrest addrest

### **Address in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I have been addressing We have been addressing
You have been addressing You have been addressing
He/She/It has been addressing They have been addressing

## Address in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I addressed or (obsolete) addrest
You addressed or (obsolete) addrest
You addressed or (obsolete) addrest
You addressed or (obsolete) addrest

He/She/It addressed or (obsolete) addrest They addressed or (obsolete) addrest



## Address in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I was addressing We were addressing
You were addressing
He/She/It was addressing They were addressing

#### **Address in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular Plural

I had addressed or (obsolete) addrest
You had addressed or (obsolete) addrest
He/She/It had addressed or (obsolete)

We had addressed or (obsolete) addrest
You had addressed or (obsolete)
They had addressed or (obsolete)

addrest addrest

#### **Address in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I had been addressing We had been addressing
You had been addressing You had been addressing
He/She/It had been addressing They had been addressing

### **Address in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular Plural
I will address We will address

You will address
He/She/It will address
They will address

# Address in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be addressing We will be addressing
You will be addressing You will be addressing
He/She/It will be addressing They will be addressing



### **Address in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular** Plural

I will have addressed or (obsolete) We will have addressed or (obsolete)

addrest addrest

You will have addressed or (obsolete) You will have addressed or (obsolete)

addrest addrest

He/She/It will have addressed or They will have addressed or (obsolete)

(obsolete) addrest addrest

### **Address in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I will have been addressing We will have been addressing

You will have been addressing You will have been addressing

He/She/It will have been addressing They will have been addressing
