# **Conjugate Adjudg**

### Adjudg in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>adjudg</b>	We <b>adjudg</b>
You <b>adjudg</b>	You <b>adjudg</b>
He/She/It adjudges	They <b>adjudg</b>

## Adjudg in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>am adjudging</b>	We <b>are adjudging</b>
You <b>are adjudging</b>	You <b>are adjudging</b>
He/She/It is adjudging	They are adjudging

### **Adjudg in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have adjudged	We have adjudged
You <b>have adjudged</b>	You have adjudged
He/She/It has adjudged	They have adjudged

## **Adjudg in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been adjudging	We have been adjudging
You <b>have been adjudging</b>	You have been adjudging
He/She/It has been adjudging	They have been adjudging

## Adjudg in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>adjudged</b>	We <b>adjudged</b>
You <b>adjudged</b>	You <b>adjudged</b>
He/She/It adjudged	They <b>adjudged</b>

#### Adjudg in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

#### **Adjudg in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had adjudged	We had adjudged
You <b>had adjudged</b>	You had adjudged
He/She/It had adjudged	They had adjudged

#### **Adjudg in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been adjudging	We had been adjudging
You <b>had been adjudging</b>	You had been adjudging
He/She/It had been adjudging	They had been adjudging

### Adjudg in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will adjudg</b>	We <b>will adjudg</b>
You <b>will adjudg</b>	You <b>will adjudg</b>
He/She/It will adjudg	They will adjudg

#### Adjudg in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be adjudging	We <b>will be adjudging</b>
You <b>will be adjudging</b>	You <b>will be adjudging</b>
He/She/It will be adjudging	They will be adjudging
