Adjudge in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

He/She/It had been adjudging They had been adjudging

Adjudge in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I will adjudge We will adjudge
You will adjudge You will adjudge
He/She/It will adjudge They will adjudge

Adjudge in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be adjudging We will be adjudging
You will be adjudging You will be adjudging
He/She/It will be adjudging They will be adjudging

Adjudge in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have adjudged

We will have adjudged

You will have adjudged

You will have adjudged

He/She/It will have adjudged **They will have adjudged**

Adjudge in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been adjudging

We will have been adjudging

You will have been adjudging

You will have been adjudging

He/She/It will have been adjudging **They will have been adjudging**
