Adjudicate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I adjudicate
You adjudicate
He/She/It adjudicates
They adjudicate

Adjudicate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am adjudicating We are adjudicating
You are adjudicating
He/She/It is adjudicating They are adjudicating

Adjudicate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have adjudicated We have adjudicated You have adjudicated You have adjudicated He/She/It has adjudicated They have adjudicated

Adjudicate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been adjudicating
You have been adjudicating
He/She/It has been adjudicating
They have been adjudicating

Adjudicate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I adjudicated We adjudicated
You adjudicated You adjudicated
He/She/It adjudicated They adjudicated

Adjudicate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was adjudicating
You were adjudicating
He/She/It was adjudicating
They were adjudicating

Adjudicate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had adjudicated We had adjudicated You had adjudicated He/She/It had adjudicated They had adjudicated

Adjudicate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been adjudicating
You had been adjudicating
He/She/It had been adjudicating
They had been adjudicating

Adjudicate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will adjudicate
You will adjudicate
He/She/It will adjudicate
They will adjudicate

Adjudicate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be adjudicating
You will be adjudicating
He/She/It will be adjudicating
They will be adjudicating

Adjudicate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have adjudicated
You will have adjudicated
He/She/It will have adjudicated
They will have adjudicated

Adjudicate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been adjudicating
You will have been adjudicating
He/She/It will have been adjudicating
They will have been adjudicating
