

### Definitions of "Adjustable" as an adjective

- *Able to be adjusted.*
- *Capable of being regulated.*
- *Capable of being changed so as to match or fit.*



## Synonyms of "Adjustable" as an adjective (8 Words)

<b><u>accommodating</u></b>	Obliging; willing to do favors. <i>The warden was always <b>accommodating</b> in allowing visitors in.</i>
<b><u>adaptable</u></b>	Able to adjust to new conditions. <i>The frame was <b>adaptable</b> to cloth bolts of different widths.</i>
<b>alterable</b>	(of the punishment ordered by a court) capable of being changed to one less severe.
<b>convertible</b>	Able to be changed in form, function, or character. <i>A formal commitment by the East European countries to <b>convertible</b> currencies.</i>
<b>modifiable</b>	Capable of being modified in form or character or strength (especially by making less extreme) – Alexis Carrel.
<b>multiway</b>	Having several paths, routes, or channels. <i>A <b>multiway</b> switch.</i>

**variable**

Not consistent or having a fixed pattern; liable to change.

**Variable** winds.

**versatile**

Able to adapt or be adapted to many different functions or activities.

An insect's **versatile** antennae can move up and down or laterally.



**Usage Examples of "Adjustable" as an adjective**

- *Adjustable seat belts.*
- *An adjustable spanner.*
- *The car has fully adjustable seats and steering wheel.*
- *Adjustable interest rates.*

### **ductile**

(of a metal) able to be drawn out into a thin wire.

**Ductile** copper.

### **ductility**

The malleability of something that can be drawn into threads or wires or hammered into thin sheets.

<b>elastic</b>	A fabric made of yarns containing an elastic material. <i>A youthful and <b>elastic</b> walk.</i>
<b>environment</b>	The area in which something exists or lives. <i>Survival in an often hostile <b>environment</b>.</i>
<b>flexibility</b>	The property of being flexible; easily bent or shaped. <i>He enjoyed the <b>flexibility</b> of his working arrangement.</i>
<u><b>flexible</b></u>	Bending and snapping back readily without breaking. <i><b>Flexible</b> rubber seals.</i>
<u><b>impressionable</b></u>	Easily impressed or influenced. <i>An <b>impressionable</b> youngster.</i>
<b>limber</b>	Attach the limber. <i><b>Limber</b> a cannon.</i>
<u><b>malleable</b></u>	Easily influenced; pliable. <i>A <b>malleable</b> metal can be beaten into a sheet.</i>
<b>plasticity</b>	The adaptability of an organism to changes in its environment or differences between its various habitats. <i>Fine clay at the right degree of <b>plasticity</b> is more useful.</i>
<u><b>pliable</b></u>	Able to adjust readily to different conditions. <i><b>Pliable</b> teenage minds.</i>
<b>pliant</b>	Able to adjust readily to different conditions. <i>A more <b>pliant</b> prime minister.</i>
<b>readjust</b>	Adjust or adapt to a changed situation. <i>After moving back to America he had to <b>readjust</b>.</i>
<b>responsiveness</b>	The quality of reacting quickly and positively. <i>A bank s <b>responsiveness</b> to customer problems engenders trust.</i>
<b>saddle</b>	Put a saddle on a horse. <i>He s <b>saddled</b> with debts of 12 million.</i>
<b>setting</b>	The set of facts or circumstances that surround a situation or event. <i>If you find the room getting too hot check the thermostat <b>setting</b>.</i>
<b>stanchion</b>	An upright bar, post, or frame forming a support or barrier.
<b>strap</b>	Sharpen with a strap. <i>The children were <b>strapped</b> into their car seats.</i>
<u><b>susceptible</b></u>	(often followed by `of` or `to`) yielding readily to or capable of. <i>Patients with liver disease may be <b>susceptible</b> to infection.</i>
<b>tensile</b>	Capable of being drawn out or stretched. <i>A <b>tensile</b> steel rod.</i>
<b>thermostat</b>	Control the temperature with a thermostat.

<b>tractability</b>	The trait of being easily persuaded.
<b><u>tractable</u></b>	(of a person) easy to control or influence. <i>The natives being of an intelligent <b>tractable</b> disposition.</i>
<b><u>versatile</u></b>	Changeable; inconstant. <i>A <b>versatile</b> writer.</i>
<b>warp</b>	In weaving arrange yarn so as to form the warp of a piece of cloth. <i>The <b>warp</b> or muddy deposit dug from an old riverbed.</i>
<b>waxy</b>	Easily impressed or influenced. <i>Careful the floor is <b>waxy</b>.</i>
