### **Definitions of "Adventurer" as a noun**

- *A person who enjoys taking risks.*
- *A mercenary soldier.*
- *Someone who travels into little known regions (especially for some scientific purpose).*
- *A person willing to take risks or use dishonest methods for personal gain.*
- *A financial speculator.*
- *A person who enjoys or seeks adventure.*



## Synonyms of "Adventurer" as a noun (12 Words)

### crusader

A warrior who engages in a holy war.

***Crusaders** for early detection and treatment of mental illnesses.*

### daredevil

A reckless person who enjoys doing dangerous things.

*Spectators watched in horror as the nineteen year old **daredevil** smashed into the ground.*

### **explorer**

Someone who travels into little known regions (especially for some scientific purpose).

*A polar **explorer**.*

### hero

A person who is admired for their courage, outstanding achievements, or noble qualities.

*The **hero** of Kipling's story.*

### **heroine**

The main good female character in a work of fiction.

*Jane Austen's **heroines**.*

<b>knight errant</b>	Originally a person of noble birth trained to arms and chivalry; today in Great Britain a person honored by the sovereign for personal merit.
<b>seeker of adventures</b>	A wild and exciting undertaking (not necessarily lawful).
<b>swashbuckler</b>	A film or book portraying daring, romantic adventures. <i>He was an explorer and something of a <b>swashbuckler</b>.</i>
<b>traveller</b>	A person who holds New Age values and leads an itinerant and unconventional lifestyle. <i>Thousands of air <b>travellers</b> were left stranded.</i>
<b>venturer</b>	A merchant who undertakes a trading venture (especially a venture that sends goods overseas).
<b>voyager</b>	A traveler to a distant land (especially one who travels by sea).
<b>wanderer</b>	Someone who leads a wandering unsettled life. <i>He is a longtime seaman a rootless <b>wanderer</b>.</i>

- *Every year adventurers attempt the Canol Trail using all manner of conveyances.*
