# **Conjugate Advesperate**

Advesperate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I advesperate	We <b>advesperate</b>
You <b>advesperate</b>	You <b>advesperate</b>
He/She/It advesperates	They <b>advesperate</b>

## Advesperate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am advesperating	We are advesperating
You are advesperating	You are advesperating
He/She/It is advesperating	They are advesperating

## **Advesperate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have advesperated	We have advesperated
You have advesperated	You have advesperated
He/She/It has advesperated	They have advesperated

## **Advesperate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been advesperating	We have been advesperating
You have been advesperating	You have been advesperating
He/She/It has been advesperating	They have been advesperating

## Advesperate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I advesperated	We <b>advesperated</b>
You advesperated	You <b>advesperated</b>
He/She/It <b>advesperated</b>	They <b>advesperated</b>

#### Advesperate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was advesperating	We were advesperating
You were advesperating	You were advesperating
He/She/It was advesperating	They were advesperating

## **Advesperate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had advesperated	We had advesperated
You <b>had advesperated</b>	You had advesperated
He/She/It had advesperated	They had advesperated

## **Advesperate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been advesperating	We had been advesperating
You <b>had been advesperating</b>	You had been advesperating
He/She/It had been advesperating	They had been advesperating

## Advesperate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will advesperate	We will advesperate
You will advesperate	You <b>will advesperate</b>
He/She/It will advesperate	They will advesperate

## Advesperate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be advesperating	We <b>will be advesperating</b>
You <b>will be advesperating</b>	You <b>will be advesperating</b>
He/She/It will be advesperating	They will be advesperating
