- *A person who is very knowledgeable and enthusiastic about an activity, subject, or pastime.*



Synonyms of "Aficionado" as a noun (12 Words)

appreciator	A person who is fully aware of something and understands it. <i>Collectors and appreciators of art and culture.</i>
authority	The power to influence others, especially because of one's commanding manner or one's recognized knowledge about something. <i>He had absolute authority over his subordinates.</i>
cognoscente	An expert able to appreciate a field; especially in the fine arts. <i>The art historian as professional expert cognoscente and aficionado.</i>
<u>connoisseur</u>	An expert able to appreciate a field; especially in the fine arts. <i>A connoisseur of music.</i>
devotee	A strong believer in a particular religion or god. <i>Devotees of Krishna.</i>

expert	A person who is very knowledgeable about or skilful in a particular area. <i>An expert in healthcare.</i>
fan	A fan shaped alluvial or talus deposit at the foot of a slope. <i>A couple of ceiling fans lazily turning.</i>
fanatic	A person with an obsessive interest in and enthusiasm for a particular activity. <i>A fanatic is one who can't change his mind and won't change the subject.</i>
one of the cognoscenti	A single person or thing.
pundit	Someone who has been admitted to membership in a scholarly field. <i>Political pundits were tipping him for promotion.</i>
savant	A learned person, especially a distinguished scientist.
specialist	Practices one branch of medicine. <i>Her doctor thought her allergy was psychosomatic but he sent her to a specialist.</i>
