Synonyms of "Ageless" as an adjective (28 Words)

abiding	Lasting a long time. <i>He had an abiding respect for her.</i>
aeonian	Of or relating to a geological eon (longer than an era).
ceaseless	Constant and unending. <i>The ceaseless thunder of surf.</i>
changeless	Not subject or susceptible to change or variation in form or quality or nature. <i>Changeless truths.</i>

classic	Very typical of its kind. <i>Hamlet is the classic example of a tragedy.</i>
deathless	Living or lasting forever; immortal. <i>Pages of deathless prose.</i>
enduring	Unceasing. <i>He formed a number of enduring relationships with women.</i>
eonian	Continuing forever or indefinitely.
eternal	Lasting or existing forever; without end. <i>Eternal nagging demands.</i>
everlasting	Continuing forever or indefinitely. <i>Life everlasting.</i>
immortal	Living forever; never dying or decaying. <i>Our mortal bodies are inhabited by immortal souls.</i>
immutable	Unchanging over time or unable to be changed. <i>The immutable laws of nature.</i>
imperishable	Unceasing. <i>Imperishable truths.</i>
indestructible	Not easily destroyed. <i>Indestructible plastic containers.</i>
invariable	(of a noun in an inflected language) having the same form in both the singular and the plural, as does <i>relais</i> in French. <i>His invariable courtesy.</i>
lasting	Lasting a long time without change. <i>A lasting happy marriage.</i>
never dying	Eagerly desirous.
perennial	Apparently permanently engaged in a specified role or way of life. <i>Perennial efforts to stipulate the requirements.</i>
permanent	Lasting or intended to last or remain unchanged indefinitely. <i>Some temporary workers did not want a permanent job.</i>
perpetual	Denoting or having a position, job, or trophy held for life. <i>Their perpetual money worries.</i>
timeless	Not affected by the passage of time or changes in fashion. <i>Helen s timeless beauty.</i>
unceasing	Continuing forever or indefinitely. <i>The unceasing efforts of the staff.</i>
unchanging	Not changing; remaining the same. <i>The party stood for unchanging principles.</i>

<u>undying</u>	(especially of an emotion) lasting forever. <i>His undying fame.</i>
<u>unending</u>	Having or seeming to have no end. <i>The unending bliss of heaven.</i>
unfading	Not losing brightness, vitality, or strength. <i>Then with smile unfading he handed the envelope to Lewis.</i>
<u>unfailing</u>	Unceasing. <i>An unfailing test.</i>
unvarying	Unvarying in nature. <i>The unvarying routine of parsonage life.</i>
