distend Become wider.

The abdomen **distend**ed rapidly.

diversify Make or become more diverse or varied.

Diversify a course of study.

dramatize Adapt (a novel) or present (a particular incident) as a play or film.

His play **dramatize**d the plight of Maureen a pregnant young woman.

elaborately With elaboration.

It was **elaborately** spelled out.

Long in relation to width elongated.

elongate Elongate fishes.

embellish

Make more attractive by adding ornament, colour, etc.

Blue silk **embellish**ed with golden embroidery.

enlarge Develop a larger print of (a photograph.

Very often a favourite photograph is **enlarge**d and framed.

escalation An increase in the intensity or seriousness of something; an intensification.

Cost **escalation**s.

expand Expand the influence of.

Their business **expand**ed into other hotels.

expandedBeing or having been enlarged or extended.

The **expanded** fins of the ray.

expansion A discussion that provides additional information.

The **expansion** of a b 2 is a 2 2ab b 2.

extend Continue or extend.

Extend the TV antenna.

lengthen Make or become longer.

The mascara will **lengthen** your lashes.



magnification A photographic print that has been enlarged.

The lines are only visible under high magnification.

Praise highly; glorify.

maximize Make as large or great as possible.

A thriller that **maximize**s the potential of its locations.

prolongation Extension of the duration of something.

An agreement on further **prolongation** of the boundary proved difficult.

Prolong.

stretch The fact or condition of a muscle being stretched.

A four year **stretch** for tax fraud.

stretched Extended or spread over a wide area or distance.

Well **stretched** muscles are less susceptible to injury.

stretching Exercise designed to extend the limbs and muscles to their full extent.

swell A welling up of a feeling.

She felt herself **swell** with pride.

widen Become broader or wider or more extensive.

The road **widen**ed.
