magnification	A photographic print that has been enlarged. The lines are only visible under high magnification .
<u>magnify</u>	Praise highly; glorify. Praise the Lord and magnify Him.
<u>maximize</u>	Make as large or great as possible. A thriller that maximize s the potential of its locations.
prolongation	Extension of the duration of something. An agreement on further prolongation of the boundary proved difficult.
protract	Prolong. He had certainly taken his time even protract ing the process.
stretch	The fact or condition of a muscle being stretched. A four year stretch for tax fraud.
stretched	Extended or spread over a wide area or distance. Well stretched muscles are less susceptible to injury.
stretching	Exercise designed to extend the limbs and muscles to their full extent.
swell	A welling up of a feeling. She felt herself swell with pride.
widen	Become broader or wider or more extensive. <i>The road widen</i> ed.
