# **Conjugate Aggravate**

#### **Aggravate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I aggravate	We <b>aggravate</b>
You <b>aggravate</b>	You <b>aggravate</b>
He/She/It aggravates	They <b>aggravate</b>

#### **Aggravate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am aggravating	We are aggravating
You <b>are aggravating</b>	You <b>are aggravating</b>
He/She/It is aggravating	They are aggravating

#### **Aggravate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have aggravated	We have aggravated
You have aggravated	You have aggravated
He/She/It has aggravated	They have aggravated

## **Aggravate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been aggravating	We have been aggravating
You <b>have been aggravating</b>	You have been aggravating
He/She/It has been aggravating	They have been aggravating

#### **Aggravate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I aggravated	We <b>aggravated</b>
You <b>aggravated</b>	You <b>aggravated</b>
He/She/It aggravated	They <b>aggravated</b>

#### **Aggravate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was aggravating	We were aggravating
You were aggravating	You were aggravating
He/She/It was aggravating	They were aggravating

#### **Aggravate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had aggravated	We had aggravated
You had aggravated	You had aggravated
He/She/It had aggravated	They had aggravated

#### **Aggravate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been aggravating	We had been aggravating
You <b>had been aggravating</b>	You had been aggravating
He/She/It had been aggravating	They had been aggravating

## Aggravate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will aggravate	We will aggravate
You <b>will aggravate</b>	You <b>will aggravate</b>
He/She/It will aggravate	They will aggravate

## Aggravate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be aggravating	We will be aggravating
You <b>will be aggravating</b>	You will be aggravating
He/She/It will be aggravating	They will be aggravating
