#### Definitions of "Agrees" as a verb

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "agrees" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- Achieve harmony of opinion, feeling, or purpose.
- Be in accord; be in agreement.
- Be agreeable or suitable.
- Be compatible, similar or consistent; coincide in their characteristics.
- Consent or assent to a condition, or agree to do something.
- Go together.
- Show grammatical agreement.

Shift from one side of the ship to the other.


