intent Intention or purpose.

intention A thing intended; an aim or plan. Good intentions are not enough.

intentionality Expressive of intentions.

**knowingly** With full knowledge and deliberation.

Amy looked at me **knowingly**.

mean Mean or intend to express or convey.

They **mean** no harm.

**objective** The objective case. **Objective** evidence.

opportunist Opportunistic.

Most burglaries are committed by casual **opportunist**s.

Propose or intend.

Roy Thomson was **propose**d as chairman.

The pervading meaning or tenor.

The letter **purport**s to express people s opinion.

The quality of being determined to do or achieve something firmness of

purpose

There was a new sense of **purpose** in her step as she set off.

Intentional.

**purposeful**If his sudden death was not accidental it must have been **purposeful**.

On purpose; intentionally.
