## Associations of "Aiming" (30 Words)

<b><a href="#">accusatory</a></b>	Containing or expressing accusation- O.Henry. <i>He pointed an <b>accusatory</b> finger in her direction.</i>
<b><a href="#">aimless</a></b>	Aimlessly drifting. <i>An <b>aimless</b> existence.</i>
<b><a href="#">animus</a></b>	A feeling of ill will arousing active hostility. <i>The reformist <b>animus</b> came from within the Party.</i>
<b><a href="#">aspiration</a></b>	A hope or ambition of achieving something. <i>Bathing solutions were changed by careful <b>aspiration</b>.</i>
<b><a href="#">deliberately</a></b>	In a careful and unhurried way. <i>She was working <b>deliberately</b>.</i>
<b><a href="#">designed</a></b>	Done or made or performed with purpose and intent. <i>Style is more than the deliberate and <b>designed</b> creation.</i>
<b><a href="#">goal</a></b>	An instance of sending the ball into or over the goal especially as a unit of scoring in a game. <i>He achieved his <b>goal</b> of becoming King of England.</i>
<b><a href="#">heading</a></b>	A horizontal passage made in preparation for building a tunnel. <i>He crawled on a <b>heading</b> of 90 degrees until he came to the track.</i>
<b><a href="#">impersonal</a></b>	(of a verb) used only with a formal subject (in English usually it) and expressing an action not attributable to a definite subject (as in it is snowing). <i>An <b>impersonal</b> tower block.</i>
<b><a href="#">incriminate</a></b>	Bring an accusation against; level a charge against. <i>He refused to answer questions in order not to <b>incriminate</b> himself.</i>
<b><a href="#">intended</a></b>	The person one intends to marry; one’s fiancé or fiancée. <i>She used to be my <b>intended</b>.</i>
<b><a href="#">intent</a></b>	Intention or purpose. <i>With alarm she realized his <b>intent</b>.</i>

<b><u>intention</u></b>	A thing intended; an aim or plan. <i>Good <b>intentions</b> are not enough.</i>
<b>intentionality</b>	Expressive of intentions.
<b>knowingly</b>	With full knowledge and deliberation. <i>Amy looked at me <b>knowingly</b>.</i>
<b>mean</b>	Mean or intend to express or convey. <i>They <b>mean</b> no harm.</i>
<b>objective</b>	The objective case. <i><b>Objective</b> evidence.</i>
<b><u>opportunist</u></b>	Opportunistic. <i>Most burglaries are committed by casual <b>opportunists</b>.</i>
<b><u>propose</u></b>	Propose or intend. <i>Roy Thomson was <b>proposed</b> as chairman.</i>
<b><u>purport</u></b>	The pervading meaning or tenor. <i>The letter <b>purports</b> to express people s opinion.</i>
<b>purpose</b>	The quality of being determined to do or achieve something firmness of purpose. <i>There was a new sense of <b>purpose</b> in her step as she set off.</i>
<b>purposeful</b>	Intentional. <i>If his sudden death was not accidental it must have been <b>purposeful</b>.</i>
<b>purposely</b>	On purpose; intentionally. <i>She had <b>purposely</b> made it difficult.</i>
<b>purposive</b>	Having or showing or acting with a purpose or design. <i><b>Purposive</b> behavior.</i>
<b>reconfirm</b>	Confirm again. <i>Berghofer resigned but was <b>reconfirmed</b> as mayor of Dresden shortly afterwards.</i>
<b>skillfully</b>	With skill. <i>Fragments of a nearly complete jug <b>skillfully</b> restored at the institute of archaeology.</i>
<b>squarely</b>	In a direct and uncompromising manner. <i>The responsibility lies <b>squarely</b> with them.</i>
<b><u>target</u></b>	The location of the target that is to be hit. <i>They were the <b>target</b> for a wave of abuse from the press.</i>
<b>teleology</b>	The explanation of phenomena in terms of the purpose they serve rather than of the cause by which they arise. <i>No theory of history can do without <b>teleology</b>.</i>
