asinine	Extremely stupid or foolish. <i>Lydia ignored his asinine remark.</i>
benighted	Lacking enlightenment or knowledge or culture. <i>Benighted or nighted travelers hurrying toward home.</i>
dolt	A stupid person.
dullard	A person who is not very bright. <i>He was caricatured as a dupe and a dullard.</i>
dumb	Make dumb or unheard silence. <i>Dumb officials make some really dumb decisions.</i>
fatuity	A ludicrous folly.
fatuous	Extremely silly or stupid. <i>A fatuous comment.</i>
folly	A foolish act, idea, or practice. <i>An act of sheer folly.</i>
fool	Fool or hoax. <i>She had been fooling herself in thinking she could remain indifferent.</i>
foolery	Foolish or senseless behavior. <i>We endured his foolery all afternoon.</i>
foolhardy	Recklessly bold or rash. <i>It would be foolhardy to go into the scheme without support.</i>
idiot	A person of subnormal intelligence.
idiotic	Very stupid. <i>An idiotic idea.</i>
ignorance	The lack of knowledge or education. <i>He acted in ignorance of basic procedures.</i>
ignorant	Unaware because of a lack of relevant information or knowledge. <i>He was completely ignorant of the circumstances.</i>

imbecile	Stupid; idiotic. <i>Try not to make imbecile remarks.</i>
inane	Extremely silly or stupid. <i>Don't badger people with inane questions.</i>
irresponsible	(of a person, attitude, or action) not showing a proper sense of responsibility. <i>Hasty and irresponsible action.</i>
liberal	(of education) concerned with broadening a person's general knowledge and experience, rather than with technical or professional training. <i>Sam was too liberal with the wine.</i>
patsy	A person who is gullible and easy to take advantage of. <i>There is a mischievous sparkle in his eyes that suggests he is no patsy.</i>
ridiculous	Inspiring scornful pity- Dashiell Hammett. <i>It seems absolutely ridiculous that anyone would try to pull a stunt like this.</i>
silly	Ludicrous, foolish. <i>A silly hat.</i>
stupidity	Behaviour that shows a lack of good sense or judgement. <i>A comedy of infantile stupidity.</i>
sucker	Of a plant produce suckers. <i>They attach themselves to fish by means of a sucker.</i>
twit	A silly or foolish person.
vacuity	Total lack of meaning or ideas. <i>He denounced what he considered the frivolity or vacuity of much contemporary painting.</i>
vacuous	Devoid of intelligence or thought. <i>Vacuous slogans.</i>
