- Characterized by lightness and insubstantiality; as impalpable or intangible as air.
- Open to or abounding in fresh air.
- Not treating something as serious; casual.
- Not practical or realizable; speculative.
- Giving an impression of light gracefulness and elegance.
- (of a room or building) spacious, well lit, and well ventilated.
- Delicate, as though filled with or made of air.
- Having little or no perceptible weight; so light as to resemble air.
- Characterized by lightness and insubstantiality; as impalpable or intangible as air-Thomas Carlyle.

Used chiefly as a direction or description in music soft in a guiet subdued

Thinking about or planning the future with imagination or wisdom. **visionary**

well ventilated Wise or advantageous and hence advisable.

Abounding in or exposed to the wind or breezes. <u>windy</u>
