appall	Strike with disgust or revulsion.
atrocious	Provoking horror- Winston Churchill. <i>Atrocious cruelties.</i>
chilling	The process of becoming cooler; a falling temperature. <i>A chilling account of the prisoners fate.</i>
consternation	Fear resulting from the awareness of danger. <i>To her consternation her car wouldn t start.</i>
diabolical	Showing the cunning or ingenuity or wickedness typical of a devil. <i>A singer with an absolutely diabolical voice.</i>
dreadful	Causing fear or dread or terror. <i>You re a dreadful flirt.</i>
fearfulness	The trait of being afraid.
fearsome	Causing fear or dread or terror. <i>The cat mewed displaying a fearsome set of teeth.</i>
formidable	Inspiring fear or respect through being impressively large, powerful, intense, or capable. <i>A formidable opponent.</i>
frightening	The act of inspiring with fear. <i>A frightening experience.</i>
frightful	Used for emphasis, especially of something bad. <i>A frightful mistake.</i>
frustration	An act of hindering someone’s plans or efforts. <i>The frustration of their wishes.</i>
ghastly	Shockingly repellent; inspiring horror. <i>The weather was ghastly.</i>
grisly	Shockingly repellent; inspiring horror. <i>The town was shaken by a series of grisly crimes.</i>

<u>gruesome</u>	Shockingly repellent; inspiring horror. <i>The most gruesome murder.</i>
<u>hellish</u>	Very unpleasant. <i>Hellish weather.</i>
hideous	Extremely unpleasant. <i>A hideous pattern of injustice.</i>
horrible	Provoking horror. <i>A horrible massacre.</i>
<u>horrific</u>	Causing horror. <i>Horrific injuries.</i>
<u>horrifying</u>	Provoking horror. <i>A horrifying incident.</i>
<u>horror</u>	Something that inspires horror something horrible. <i>To her horror she found that a thief had stolen the machine.</i>
<u>macabre</u>	Disturbing because concerned with or causing a fear of death. <i>Macabre tales of war and plague in the Middle ages.</i>
<u>panic</u>	Drive someone through panic into hasty action. <i>He caused an economic panic by his sudden resignation.</i>
scary	Frightening; causing fear. <i>A scary movie.</i>
<u>spooky</u>	Sinister or ghostly in a way that causes fear and unease. <i>I bet this place is really spooky late at night.</i>
terrible	Extremely unpleasant or disagreeable. <i>The weather was terrible.</i>
<u>terrifying</u>	Causing extreme terror. <i>A terrifying wail.</i>
terror	Terrorism. <i>He was the terror of the neighborhood.</i>
unsightly	Unpleasant to look at; ugly. <i>An unsightly rubbish tip.</i>
