appall	Strike with disgust or revulsion.
<u>atrocious</u>	Provoking horror- Winston Churchill. <i>An atrocious automobile accident.</i>
<u>chilling</u>	The process of becoming cooler; a falling temperature. <i>A chilling account of the prisoners fate.</i>
consternation	A feeling of anxiety or dismay, typically at something unexpected. <i>To her consternation her car wouldn't start.</i>
<u>diabolical</u>	Showing the cunning or ingenuity or wickedness typical of a devil. <i>His diabolical cunning.</i>
<u>dreadful</u>	Causing or involving great suffering, fear, or unhappiness; extremely bad or serious. <i>You're a dreadful flirt.</i>
fearfulness	The trait of being afraid.
fearsome	Causing fear or dread or terror. <i>The cat mewed displaying a fearsome set of teeth.</i>
<u>formidable</u>	Inspiring fear or respect through being impressively large, powerful, intense, or capable. <i>The challenge was formidable.</i>
<u>frightening</u>	Causing fear or dread or terror. <i>A frightening experience.</i>
frightful	Provoking horror. <i>Her hair was a frightful mess.</i>
<u>frustration</u>	The feeling of being upset or annoyed as a result of being unable to change or achieve something. <i>Tears of frustration rolled down her cheeks.</i>
<u>ghastly</u>	Very objectionable, bad, or unpleasant. <i>Ghastly wounds.</i>

grisly	Shockingly repellent; inspiring horror. <i>The town was shaken by a series of grisly crimes.</i>
<u>gruesome</u>	Extremely unpleasant. <i>The most gruesome murder.</i>
<u>hellish</u>	Very unpleasant. <i>It had been a hellish week.</i>
hideous	Extremely unpleasant. <i>Hideous lizard like creatures.</i>
horrible	Causing or likely to cause horror; shocking. <i>The tea tasted horrible.</i>
<u>horrific</u>	Grossly offensive to decency or morality; causing horror. <i>Horrific injuries.</i>
<u>horrifying</u>	Provoking horror. <i>An alarming even horrifying picture.</i>
<u>horror</u>	A literary or film genre concerned with arousing feelings of horror. <i>The mere thought of it gives me the horrors.</i>
<u>macabre</u>	Shockingly repellent; inspiring horror. <i>Macabre tortures conceived by madmen.</i>
<u>panic</u>	Cause sudden fear in or fill with sudden panic. <i>We are not going to be panicked into a decision.</i>
scary	Provoking fear terror. <i>A scary movie.</i>
<u>spooky</u>	Sinister or ghostly in a way that causes fear and unease. <i>I bet this place is really spooky late at night.</i>
terrible	Causing or likely to cause terror; sinister. <i>A terrible cough.</i>
<u>terrifying</u>	Causing extreme fear. <i>The terrifying events of the past few weeks.</i>
terror	Terrorism. <i>He was the terror of the neighborhood.</i>
unsightly	Unpleasant to look at. <i>Unsightly billboards.</i>
