appall	Strike with disgust or revulsion.
<u>atrocious</u>	Provoking horror- Winston Churchill. An atrocious automobile accident.
<u>chilling</u>	The process of becoming cooler; a falling temperature. A chilling account of the prisoners fate.
consternation	A feeling of anxiety or dismay, typically at something unexpected. <i>To her consternation her car wouldn t start.</i>
<u>diabolical</u>	Showing the cunning or ingenuity or wickedness typical of a devil. <i>His diabolical cunning.</i>
<u>dreadful</u>	Causing or involving great suffering, fear, or unhappiness; extremely bad or serious. <i>You re a dreadful flirt.</i>
fearfulness	The trait of being afraid.
fearsome	Causing fear or dread or terror. The cat mewed displaying a fearsome set of teeth.
<u>formidable</u>	Inspiring fear or respect through being impressively large, powerful, intense, or capable. <i>The challenge was formidable</i> .
<u>frightening</u>	Causing fear or dread or terror. A frightening experience.
frightful	Provoking horror. Her hair was a frightful mess.
<u>frustration</u>	The feeling of being upset or annoyed as a result of being unable to change or achieve something. <i>Tears of frustration rolled down her cheeks.</i>
<u>ghastly</u>	Very objectionable, bad, or unpleasant. <i>Ghastly</i> wounds.



grisly	Shockingly repellent; inspiring horror. The town was shaken by a series of grisly crimes.
<u>gruesome</u>	Extremely unpleasant. The most gruesome murder.
<u>hellish</u>	Very unpleasant. It had been a hellish week.
hideous	Extremely unpleasant. <i>Hideous</i> lizard like creatures.
horrible	Causing or likely to cause horror; shocking. The tea tasted horrible .
<u>horrific</u>	Grossly offensive to decency or morality; causing horror. <i>Horrific</i> injuries.
<u>horrifying</u>	Provoking horror. An alarming even horrifying picture.
<u>horror</u>	A literary or film genre concerned with arousing feelings of horror. <i>The mere thought of it gives me the horrors.</i>
<u>macabre</u>	Shockingly repellent; inspiring horror. <i>Macabre</i> tortures conceived by madmen.
<u>panic</u>	Cause sudden fear in or fill with sudden panic. We are not going to be panic ked into a decision.
scary	Provoking fear terror. A scary movie.
<u>spooky</u>	Sinister or ghostly in a way that causes fear and unease. I bet this place is really spooky late at night.
terrible	Causing or likely to cause terror; sinister. A terrible cough.
<u>terrifying</u>	Causing extreme fear. The terrifying events of the past few weeks.
terror	Terrorism. He was the terror of the neighborhood.
unsightly	Unpleasant to look at. Unsightly billboards.
