Infinitive	<b>to albuminize</b>
Present Tense	<b>albuminize / albuminizes</b>
Past Tense	<b>albuminized</b>
Present Participle	<b>albuminizing</b>
Past Participle	<b>albuminized</b>

## Conjugate Albuminize

**Albuminize in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>albuminize</b>	We <b>albuminize</b>
You <b>albuminize</b>	You <b>albuminize</b>
He/She/It <b>albuminizes</b>	They <b>albuminize</b>

**Albuminize in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am albuminizing</b>	We <b>are albuminizing</b>
You <b>are albuminizing</b>	You <b>are albuminizing</b>
He/She/It <b>is albuminizing</b>	They <b>are albuminizing</b>

**Albuminize in Present Perfect Tense**

I <b>have albuminized</b>	We <b>have albuminized</b>
You <b>have albuminized</b>	You <b>have albuminized</b>
He/She/It <b>has albuminized</b>	They <b>have albuminized</b>

**Albuminize in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>have been albuminizing</b>	We <b>have been albuminizing</b>
You <b>have been albuminizing</b>	You <b>have been albuminizing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been albuminizing</b>	They <b>have been albuminizing</b>

**Albuminize in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was albuminizing**      We **were albuminizing**  
You **were albuminizing**      You **were albuminizing**  
He/She/It **was albuminizing**      They **were albuminizing**

**Albuminize in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had albuminized**      We **had albuminized**  
You **had albuminized**      You **had albuminized**  
He/She/It **had albuminized**      They **had albuminized**

**Albuminize in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I **had been albuminizing**      We **had been albuminizing**  
You **had been albuminizing**      You **had been albuminizing**  
He/She/It **had been albuminizing**      They **had been albuminizing**

**Albuminize in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I **will albuminize**      We **will albuminize**  
You **will albuminize**      You **will albuminize**  
He/She/It **will albuminize**      They **will albuminize**

**Albuminize in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I **will be albuminizing**      We **will be albuminizing**  
You **will be albuminizing**      You **will be albuminizing**  
He/She/It **will be albuminizing**      They **will be albuminizing**
