- *Anyone who does not belong in the environment in which they are found.*
- *A person who comes from a foreign country; someone who does not owe allegiance to your country.*



## Synonyms of "Aliens" as a noun (7 Words)

<b><u>extraterrestrial</u></b>	A form of life assumed to exist outside the Earth or its atmosphere.
<b>extraterrestrial being</b>	A form of life assumed to exist outside the Earth or its atmosphere.
<b>foreigner</b>	A person born in or coming from a country other than one's own.
<b>noncitizen</b>	A person who comes from a foreign country; someone who does not owe allegiance to your country.
<b>outlander</b>	A person who comes from a foreign country; someone who does not owe allegiance to your country. <i>Here in the city I feel like a perpetual <b>outlander</b>.</i>
<b><u>stranger</u></b>	A person who does not know, or is not known in, a particular place or community. <i>She remained a <b>stranger</b> to him.</i>
<b>unknown</b>	An unknown and unexplored region. <i>She is a relative <b>unknown</b>.</i>



## Aliens as a Verb

### Definitions of "Aliens" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "aliens" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Arouse hostility or indifference in where there had formerly been love, affection, or friendliness.*
- *Transfer property or ownership.*





## Synonyms of "Aliens" as a verb (1 Word)

**alienate** Make (someone) feel isolated or estranged.  
*The boring work **alienated** his employees.*



## Usage Examples of "Aliens" as a verb

- *The will aliened the property to the heirs.*





## **Aliens as an Adjective**

### **Definitions of "Aliens" as an adjective**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "aliens" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not contained in or deriving from the essential nature of something.*
- *Being or from or characteristic of another place or part of the world.*



## Synonyms of "Aliens" as an adjective (2 Words)

**exotic** Originating in or characteristic of a distant foreign country.  
*Exotic plants in a greenhouse.*

**foreign** Of concern to or concerning the affairs of other nations (other than your own).  
*Foreign particles in milk.*





## Usage Examples of "Aliens" as an adjective

- *An economic theory alien to the spirit of capitalism.*
- *Alien customs.*





## Associations of "Aliens" (30 Words)

- aerospace** The atmosphere and outer space considered as a whole.
- astronaut** A person trained to travel in a spacecraft.  
*The Russians called their **astronauts** cosmonauts.*
- blimp** A soundproof cover for a cine camera.  
*I could work out four hours a day and still end up a **blimp**.*
- confuse** Make unclear, indistinct, or blurred.  
*The points made by the authors **confuse** rather than clarify the issue.*
- dissimilar** Marked by dissimilarity.  
*A group of very **dissimilar** people.*

<b><u>existential</u></b>	Of or as conceived by existentialism. <i>Formal logicians are not concerned with <b>existential</b> matters.</i>
<b>exotic</b>	An exotic plant or animal. <i>Youths with <b>exotic</b> haircuts.</i>
<b>expatriate</b>	A person who lives outside their native country. <i>We <b>expatriated</b> the prisoners of war immediately after the end of the war.</i>
<b><u>extraterrestrial</u></b>	A form of life assumed to exist outside the Earth or its atmosphere. <i>Searches for <b>extraterrestrial</b> intelligence.</i>
<b><u>foreign</u></b>	Of or belonging to another district or area. <i>A <b>foreign</b> office.</i>
<b>foreigner</b>	A person born in or coming from a country other than one's own.
<b>helicopter</b>	Fly somewhere in a helicopter. <i>They were <b>helicoptering</b> daily between Bath and London.</i>
<b>interstellar</b>	Between or among stars. <i><b>Interstellar</b> travel.</i>
<b>irrespective</b>	Not taking (something) into account; regardless of. <i>Child benefit is paid <b>irrespective</b> of income levels.</i>
<b>lander</b>	A spacecraft designed to land on the surface of a planet or moon. <i>A lunar <b>lander</b>.</i>
<b>oddity</b>	The quality of being strange or peculiar. <i>Realizing the <b>oddity</b> of the remark he retracted it.</i>
<b><u>outcast</u></b>	A person who has been rejected or ostracized by their society or social group. <i>She went from trusted pal to ostracized <b>outcast</b> overnight.</i>
<b><u>outsider</u></b>	A competitor, applicant, etc. thought to have little chance of success. <i>He started as a rank <b>outsider</b>.</i>
<b>paranormal</b>	Not in accordance with scientific laws. <i>An investigator of the <b>paranormal</b>.</i>
<b>shuttle</b>	Transport in a shuttle. <i>The river taxi <b>shuttled</b> employees between the newspaper s offices and the capital.</i>
<b>spacecraft</b>	A vehicle used for travelling in space.
<b>spaceman</b>	A person trained to travel in a spacecraft.
<b>spaceship</b>	A spacecraft, especially one controlled by a crew.



- strange** Being definitely out of the ordinary and unexpected; slightly odd or even a bit weird.  
*She was lost in a **strange** country.*
- stranger** Anyone who does not belong in the environment in which they are found.  
*He is no **stranger** to controversy.*
- totally** To a complete degree or to the full or entire extent (‘whole’ is often used informally for ‘wholly’).  
*She is almost **totally** deaf.*
- traveler** A person who changes location.
- universe** All existing matter and space considered as a whole the cosmos The universe is believed to be at least 10 billion light years in diameter and contains a vast number of galaxies it has been expanding since its creation in the Big Bang about 13 billion years ago.  
*The front parlour was the hub of her **universe**.*
- unrelated** Lacking a logical or causal relation.  
***Unrelated** facts.*
- westerner** A native or inhabitant of the west, especially of western Europe or North America.
