## Synonyms of "Aligns" as a verb (6 Words)

- adjust** Place in a line or arrange so as to be parallel or straight.  
*His eyes had **adjusted** to semi darkness.*
- aline** Place in a line or arrange so as to be parallel or straight.
- array** Dress someone in (the clothes specified).  
*They were **arrayed** in Hungarian national dress.*
- coordinate** Form a coordinate bond to an atom or molecule.  
*These activities **coordinate** well.*
- line up** Fill plentifully.
- ordinate** Bring (components or parts) into proper or desirable coordination correlation.  
***Ordinate** similar parts.*





## Usage Examples of "Aligns" as a verb

- *Align the wheels of my car.*
- *Align the sheets of paper on the table.*
- *Align the car with the curb.*



## Associations of "Aligns" (30 Words)

**adapt**

Adapt or conform oneself to new or different conditions.  
*A large organization can be slow to **adapt** to change.*

**adjust**

Decide how much is to be paid on an insurance claim.  
*A single control **adjusts** the water flow.*

**aligned**

In a straight line.  
*Pearly teeth evenly **aligned**.*

**alongside**

Side by side.

<b>arrange</b>	Make arrangements for. <i>Arrange my schedule.</i>
<b>array</b>	An indexed set of related elements. <i>A bewildering <b>array</b> of choices.</i>
<b>battalion</b>	An army unit usually consisting of a headquarters and three or more companies. <i>A <b>battalion</b> of ants.</i>
<b>brigade</b>	Form or unite into a brigade. <i>He commanded a <b>brigade</b> of 3 000 men.</i>
<b>configuration</b>	Any spatial attributes (especially as defined by outline). <i>The PC comes with a removable hard disk drive as part of the standard <b>configuration</b>.</i>
<b>contour</b>	Form the contours of. <i>The figure shows <b>contours</b> of 21 cm line emission of atomic hydrogen.</i>
<b>coordinate</b>	Form a coordinate bond to an atom or molecule. <i>The sodium atom is <b>coordinated</b> to two oxygen atoms.</i>
<b>deploy</b>	(of troops) move into position for military action. <i>The air force began to <b>deploy</b> forward.</i>
<b>elongate</b>	Long in relation to width elongated. <i>The pup s globular body slowly <b>elongates</b>.</i>
<b>horizontally</b>	In a horizontal position or direction. <i>Labels are placed <b>horizontally</b> on the cases.</i>
<b>line</b>	Mark or cover with lines. <i><b>Lines</b> of communication were set up between the two firms.</i>
<b>lineation</b>	The act of marking or outlining with lines. <i>Magnetic <b>lineations</b>.</i>
<b>longitudinal</b>	Of or relating to lines of longitude. <i>A <b>longitudinal</b> study of ten patients.</i>
<b>matrix</b>	The cultural, social, or political environment in which something develops. <i>Such fossils will often be partly concealed by <b>matrix</b>.</i>
<b>order</b>	A thing made supplied or served as a result of an order. <i>The British ships dropped anchor and waited for <b>orders</b> from London.</i>
<b>ordering</b>	Logical or comprehensible arrangement of separate elements. <i>There were mistakes in the <b>ordering</b> of items on the list.</i>
<b>organize</b>	Bring order and organization to. <i><b>Organize</b> a strike.</i>

<b>oriented</b>	Adjusted or located in relation to surroundings or circumstances; sometimes used in combination. <i>The house had its large windows <b>oriented</b> toward the ocean view.</i>
<b>parallel</b>	One of a set of parallel geometric figures parallel lines or planes. <i><b>Parallel</b> processing.</i>
<b>perpendicular</b>	Perpendicular position or direction. <i>Dormers and gables that extend <b>perpendicular</b> to the main roofline.</i>
<b>plumb</b>	Conforming to the direction of a plumb line. <i>The tower of Pisa is far out of <b>plumb</b>.</i>
<b>relocation</b>	The transportation of people (as a family or colony) to a new settlement (as after an upheaval of some kind). <i>The planned <b>relocation</b> of national headquarters to Warwickshire.</i>
<b>setup</b>	An act that incriminates someone on a false charge. <i>It takes time to learn the <b>setup</b> around here.</i>
<b>temporary</b>	A worker especially in an office hired on a temporary basis. <i><b>Temporary</b> housing.</i>
<b>vertical</b>	A vertical structural member as a post or stake. <i>Keep your back <b>vertical</b>.</i>
<b>vertically</b>	At right angles to a horizontal plane; aligned in such a way that the top is directly above the bottom. <i><b>Vertically</b> integrated companies.</i>
